WORK

"The typical work week is Monday through Friday from 9am – 4pm. The first day at the Depot includes a morning orientation detailing the work of UMCOR in general, the UMCOR Material Resources division, as well as specifics of working at UMCOR West Office and Depot. Further, it is suggested that a half day at UMCOR West Office and Depot will be spend working off site at another humanitarian agency to be determined by UMCOR West Office and Depot staff. The second half of that day is usually spent sightseeing and recreating.

"Keep in mind that schedules during the week are flexible, but volunteers may work assembling kits in the depot, cleaning the volunteer space, or outside the depot doing work in the community with various service projects. On the final workday, volunteers will gather again for a time of reflection, worship and planning for taking their experience to their home congregations."

- -there is also a sewing room for various projects
- -work is suitable for most ages and abilities/ any children will need to be supervised by their own parents or guardians

LODGING

Most rooms have two twin beds each, and shared bathroom between two rooms Hospitality Kitchen, where we would make most of our meals/ pack lunches for work site

COSTS

UMCOR Depot \$20/ member processing fee

Housing \$180 [\$30/person (\$55/ rooms per night, 2 person occupancy)]

Food \$100/ person (\$20/ day per person)

UMCOR Donation *\$50/volunteer (or kit resources, 5-10 kits per volunteer)

Total: \$300 (if we gather UMCOR kit donations) / *\$350 if we give the \$50 donation to UMCOR/person)

(We will work out adjustments for families with small children/ max amount for families)

NOT INCLUDED: gas money to and from/ meals on the way there and back/ any additional activities or outings or souvenirs

OTHER INFORMATION

- -We will drive in family or carpooling groups, leaving after church on Sunday, August 6th and driving back on Saturday, August 13th. All transportation for daily activities will be the responsibility of each person/family.
- -Our work will be Monday- Friday. Our evenings and one afternoon will be free for activities that we will plan together. Ideas: visit Temple Square, visit the Great Salt Lake, local amusement park/swimming pool
- -For families with children/youth parents or guardians will be in charge of their own children at all times
- -We may not be able to accommodate severe food allergies
