## **BALLOT OF OFFICERS/BOARD MEMBERS**

Officers shall be elected and installed at the Annual June Intergroup meeting. Nominations of eligible individuals (see eligibility requirements for each officer below) can be made by the groups. Group nominations can be submitted on the ballot circulated by the Intergroup representatives. The Intergroup is responsible for reviewing the ballots of eligible candidates and vote on at the June Intergroup meeting. A simple majority of the Intergroup members is needed for the annual election. Positions left vacant before term expirations shall be filled by the Intergroup at a special election from qualified candidates.

**Chairperson**: Elected to a (1) one year term and can be re-elected for a (1) year term by the members of the Intergroup, but not to exceed (3) three consecutive years.

## Requirements:

- Three (3) years of sobriety
- A member of the Intergroup for (6) six months

## Duties:

- To preside over Intergroup meetings
- To appoint special committees as authorized by the Intergroup
- Vote as a tie breaker only

CANDIDATES:
