CTC-RI invites Rhode Island primary care practices to join a ten-month learning collaborative, funded by United Healthcare, focused on improving adult influenza immunization rates for patients ages 19–64. Rhode Island adult flu vaccination rates fall below the national 50th percentile; this program provides the tools, training, and peer support to help improve compliance.

- Improvement Model: PDSA cycles with AIM statements and quarterly progress reporting
