



Updates TO OHIC'S 2025 PCMH AND IBH REPORTING PROCESS

The Office of the Health Insurance Commissioner (OHIC) has announced important updates to its annual reporting process for practices seeking Patient-Centered Medical Home (PCMH) and Integrated Behavioral Health (IBH) recognition.

Key changes for 2025:

- New submission deadline: Starting with the 2025 reporting cycle, the PCMH and IBH survey submission deadline will shift from October to Friday, January 16, 2026.
- Insurer notification: OHIC will notify insurers of practices meeting PCMH recognition requirements and qualifying IBH practices by Friday, February 27, 2026.
- Measurement period update: Quality measure performance will now be reported for the calendar year (January 1–December 31) rather than the previous October–September period.

Survey submission requirements:

- All practices seeking OHIC PCMH recognition must:
 - Submit basic practice information
 - Indicate NCQA Practice Transformation status
 - Complete the Behavioral Health Integration survey questions
- Additional requirement for practices not participating in at least one commercial ACO population-based contract in 2025 and not part of an FQHC-based AE in 2025:
 - Complete the PCMH Quality Measures component of the survey
 - Complete the Cost Management Strategies survey

OHIC will publish updated survey instructions, tools, and measure specifications by Tuesday, September 30, 2025.
