\$180,890

Our clergy leadership and lay worship ministers lead us in joyous worship of Word and Sacrament. We are enlivened by the music of our St Philip's choirs and choral scholars under the Director of Music Ministry.

CONNECT IN COMMUNITY

\$161,574

Creating bonds of affection through play, shared meals, and study in our welcoming space for worship, fellowship, and community both within our buildings and on our grounds.

SERVE

\$76,146

Our members build ramps, collect food, tutor children, grow vegetables, deliver meals, and many other activities that serve the wider community. We also serve one another by sharing communion, flowers from the altar, and meals with those in our own parish.

GIVE

\$58,477

Our operating budget supports ministry partners such as the Diocese of Western North Carolina, Sharing House, Camp Henry Scholarship Fund, and Habitat for Humanity. In addition, last year we gave \$210,517 to community nonprofits, Episcopal Relief and Development, and the United Thank Offering through the Episcopal Church Women and the St. Philip's Foundation.
