


### Gettin' Our Groove On

# Peacing Together

The Peace Council has set a minimum goal for the Peacing Together Campaign of \$750,000 but research has shown that we have the capacity to reach (and even exceed) the stretch goal of \$950,000. # Love Maintenance of our building

Together, the people of Peace are committed to the love and care of our spacious building--facilities that not only serve the work of the congregation, but welcome the entire community.

During the past several years, a piece-meal list of capital repairs and improvements has accumulated into a total estimate of \$400,000 - \$425,000. The projects that our Church Council has prioritized for funding as funds are available include:

- · Repairing and painting the steeple
- · Remodeling the kitchen and replacing the dishwasher
- · Resurfacing parking lots and replacing lights with LED
- Repairing brick and stucco
- · Replacing several air conditioning units
- · Renovating several classrooms for our new preschool ministry
- Purchasing an electronic welcome sign













## Encourage Mortgage reduction



Together, the people of Peace are encouraged and ready to reduce the amount owed for the 2006 investment in our new sanctuary. We are encouraged by the opportunity to direct monthly mortgage payments to vital ministries once the mortgage is reduced.

As of September 30, 2022, the congregation's mortgage balance totals \$489,480. Though the operating budget congregational can adequately handle current monthly payments of \$3500, many members have a heartfelt desire to lift the burden of any congregational debt from future generations.

## Serve Mission

of Peace

Together, the people of Peace are committed to continue to serve our communities by being a tithing congregation. We give 10% to God's work in our community, through our church body, and around the world.

While the congregation supports many ministry organizations each year through its general operating budget, this campaign gives us the unique opportunity to make a smaller number of larger gifts to ministry partners. Ten percent of all gifts to the campaign will be divided equally among three missions areas:

- Local: supporting food programs
- Regional: Green Lake Lutheran Ministries
- Global: Youth for Christ Moldova Sheltering Ukrainian refugees



## Simple Steps for making your commitment



### CONSIDER YOUR CURRENT GIVING

Prayerfully consider your support for the day-to-day, year-round ministry of Peace Lutheran Church. Though this campaign is not inviting you to make a specific pledge for your regular offerings, the congregation depends on your continued and even increased unrestricted gifts.
