- Raised \$300,000 for the addition to the Blacksburg Public Library
- Raised \$300,000 for the book collection in the Meadowbrook Public Library
- Contributed to the expansion of the Jessie Peterman Memorial Library in Floyd
- Provided funding for enhancements to the Christiansburg Public Library, including an outdoor area in honor of Mary Ann Hinshelwood.
- Provided funding for the 2014 renovations in the Blacksburg Public Library
