ETFO's new Indigenous Women's Mentorship Program: The Mentee Program is a unique opportunity for Indigenous women new to ETFO or for those looking to explore union leadership opportunities with an ETFO woman mentor through the lens of Etuaptmumk, two-eyed seeing.

This mentee program is for 20 women members, who also self-identify as Indigenous, interested in:

- exploring the role of identity and intersectionality in leadership;
- building knowledge of ETFO, social justice, the broader labour movement, and opportunities for activism and leadership within the Federation; and
- developing inclusive leadership styles within an anti-oppression framework.



Qualifications to be considered as a program mentee:

- attend all sessions, (meeting times and location may vary);
- work towards increasing leadership involvement at the local and/or provincial level;
- explore issues of identity and leadership within an equity and anti-oppression framework; and
- commitment to working towards increasing leadership involvement in ETFO.
