

Limited Time Only: Pandemic Relief Rebate for Pathways: *Delivered*

Catechists are the “Keepers of the memory of God” and as such their continued spiritual formation and nourishment is a primary concern for the Diocese of Richmond.

For a limited time only, the Office of Christian Formation is offering a full rebate to parishes who register their catechists for Pathways: *Delivered* and whose catechists complete the three courses: Vocation of the Catechist, Catholic Approach to Scripture, and Catholic Tradition (\$35 per catechist). No rebates will be given after April 4, 2021.

Here are the guidelines for the Rebate:

- Parishes are to register their catechists on the Learn portal and send an email to learn@richmonddiocese.org by January 31, 2021 listing which catechists will participate in the rebate program.
- Catechists need to complete the three courses by **April 4, 2021 (Easter)**. If the catechist does not complete the training, no rebate will be given.
- Parishes will be invoiced by Catholic Faith Technologies at a rate of \$35 per catechist. It is the responsibility of the parish to pay the up-front cost for catechist formation. While it is the expectation that parishes support catechist formation, if necessary, the parish can invoice the individual catechists should they not complete the terms of the rebate.
- Once all the catechists have completed the courses and have received their certificate, the parish leader sends a copy of the invoice from the LEARN portal to learn@richmonddiocese.org.
- After receiving the invoice and confirming that the catechists have completed the courses, Office of Christian Formation will send the rebate of \$35 per catechist to the parish.
