## Rules and Expectations:

- 1. Students are expected to arrive on time to all events. Admittance closes at 7:00 pm.
- 2. Students will not be permitted reentry to the event if they leave during the event.
- 3. Students not picked up within 15 minutes of the event end time will incur a fee of \$1 per minute late (note this is the same late pick up fee as applies for after school pickup).
- 4. All school rules apply during the dance. This includes school policies about cell phone usage.
- 5. Students are not permitted guests. All attendees must be students enrolled in the Forest Heights Upper School (grades 6-8).
- 6. Students' attire must be modest and appropriate for a school function. Shirts, shorts, dresses and other clothing must cover at least as much as the normal school uniform. Shoes must be closed toe unless otherwise noted in the dress code addendum. Please see additional uniform guidelines below:
  - a. Jeans, poodle skirts, turtle necks, fun socks, and other types of 50's style clothing are encouraged for the occasion! If you choose not to dress up please follow the semi-formal dress code for events.
  - b. **For ladies** wearing skirts or dresses, hemlines should be no shorter than the uniform skirt. Bare midriffs, tight-fitting outfits, strapless tops, spaghetti-straps, and low-cut shirts are not allowed.
  - c. For young men, jeans should be in good repair, with no holes and no extreme styles. No shorts.
  - d. **Footwear -** Students can wear rubber-soled shoes or tennis shoes or dress shoes. They may also plan to dance in socks if they would like.
- 7. Students who do not follow the above rules, or other portions of the student code of conduct, may be asked to leave early. If so, parents will be called for an early pickup.
