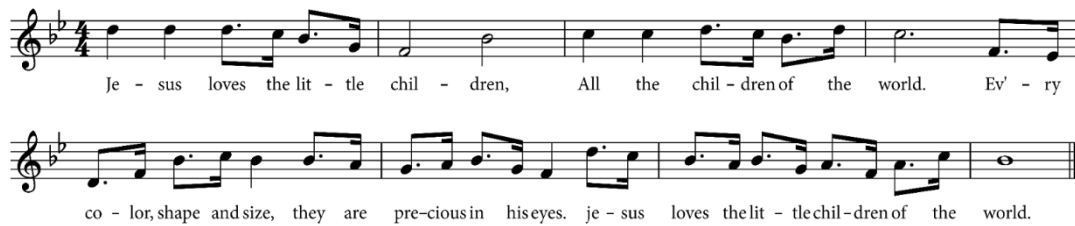

Welcome and Invitation
