

Louis Orndorff comes to us as a recently retired Air Force Colonel with over 25 years of contracting and acquisition experience. He held four commands, including Commander Defense Contract Management Agency (DCMA) Middle East where he managed administrative oversight of the Department of Defense's largest Foreign Military Sales program in U.S. history. He also Commanded, DCMA Boeing Seattle, directing management of weapons systems contracts and providing oversight to 32 Acquisition Programs including the Air Force \$35 billion KC-46 Tanker startup. In addition, he deployed as the DCMA Southern Afghanistan Commander, overseeing warzone life support service contracts. He performed duties as an AFRICOM international affairs officer, joint and combined exercises officer and has served in a broad range of aircraft maintenance, command and control operations, plans, Air Force Major Commands and DoD Worldwide Combatant Command joint-staff assignments.

Louis served as the Deputy Director of Contracting for the Air Force District of Washington, Andrews Air Force Base and Air Force Life Cycle Management Center, Hanscom Air Force Base. He provided senior level business and operations advice to assist in leading and executing multi-billion dollar contracting actions, activities and programs supporting Headquarters U.S. Air Force, Secretary of the Air Force, and 25 additional major Air Force activities in the National Capital Region. He provided senior military acquisition oversight for contracting actions covering over 300 Acquisition Programs where he executed contract clearance approval authority up to \$1B for competitive acquisitions.

Louis joined the Idaho Air National Guard in 1988 as a photo imagery processor and later cross trained as an electronic warfare technician on the F-4G Wild Weasel. He has served in various contracting positions such as command and control systems, operational contracting, and special programs contracting with unlimited warrants. He holds Acquisition Professional Development Program Level III certification in Contracting and Level I in Program Management as well as National Contracts Management Association Certified Federal and Professional Contracts Manager and Project Management Institute Certified Project Management Professional. Louis has received a BS Physics, minor in Mathematics, MS Engineering Management, MS Military Operational Art and Science with International Affairs specialty and is a graduate of USAF Air War College.
