

Obtaining HUBZone Certification

Want to compete for the HUBZone program's set-aside contracts?

This workshop allows government contractors to learn and work towards obtaining their HUBZone program certification. It will also provide some answers and direction for when and if you should get certified and how to best leverage this certification for *winning government contracts*.

Participants will have the opportunity to explore what a business has to do to qualify for the HUBZone program, program benefits & how to get certified, and what to do with certification when you obtain it.

The government limits competition for certain contracts to businesses in historically underutilized business zones. It also gives preferential consideration to those businesses in full and open competition.

Joining the HUBZone program makes your business eligible to compete for the program's set-aside contracts. HUBZone-certified businesses also get a 10 percent price evaluation preference in full and open contract competitions.

HUBZone-certified businesses can still compete for contract awards under other socio-economic programs they qualify for.
