

Bio of Dr. Jevon Johnson



Jevon Johnson, MD has been a psychiatrist with the California Department of Corrections since 2014. He has worked at the facilities in Stockton, Lone and currently Sacramento. Dr. Johnson also does consultant work for patients on parole or probation referred through the Federal Bureau of Prisons. Outside of the corrections and parole setting Dr. Johnson also treats patients at an inpatient psychiatric facility in Modesto, as well as providing outpatient services at a community clinic in South Sacramento that targets the Asian/Pacific Islander population.

Dr. Johnson completed his MD at the University of Southern California, Keck School of Medicine in Los Angeles after graduating from Xavier University in New Orleans, LA. He went on to do his residency in psychiatry at UC Davis Medical Center in Sacramento. After completing his residency Dr. Johnson worked with Veterans Affairs and Kaiser Permanente before joining the Department of Corrections. While at Kaiser Permanente Dr. Johnson lead the transition program for patients recently discharged from inpatient facilities. Dr. Johnson's career has focused on providing quality, culturally sensitive care to various underserved populations within settings that emphasize an interdisciplinary approach to mental health treatment.
