Red Flag Warning

St. Helena– The National Weather Service has issued a Red Flag Warning for gusty winds and low humidity, which is in effect from 11 a.m. Monday May 30, 2022 to 8 p.m. Tuesday May 31, 2022. A Red Flag Warning means that critical fire weather conditions are forecasted. A combination of low relative humidity, high winds, and warm temperatures can contribute to extreme fire behavior. Winds are forecasted to have gusts up to 35 mph, and low RH values of 5-15%. The Greatest threat is on the west side of the Sacramento Valley, mainly along and west of Interstate 5.
