

LIBRARY GALLERY EXHIBITION COMPETITION

Montpelier Arts Center is holding a competition for exhibitions that will be held in the Library Gallery, September 2021 – July 2022. To be eligible, artists must be 18 years and older and reside in Maryland. Previous winners from 2016 to the present are ineligible. The juror may elect to exhibit artists who apply for solo shows or artists who apply as groups.

An honorarium of \$300 will be presented for each exhibition to the artist(s) exhibition (i.e. groups would share the \$300 honorarium). Exhibitions typically run 6-8 weeks. The Montpelier Arts Center staff will handle all promotion and installation, as well as the reception. Please note, the Arts Center retains a 25% commission on sales of works sold during the exhibition.

Due to the ongoing pandemic, all exhibitions are subject to being virtual only, by appointment, and/or without a reception.

Application Requirements:

- All entries must be submitted online at montpelierartscenter.submittable.com by March 28, 2021 at 11:59 PM.
- Artist/Art Group statement.
- Current resume of all artists to exhibit.
- A proposal of no more than 500 words.
- Preferred month for your show. Include second and third choices.
- A minimum of 10 and a maximum of 15 digital images that best exemplify your portfolio/proposal. Images must be in JPEG format at a minimum of 300 dpi.

All entries must be submitted online at montpelierartscenter.submittable.com
by Sunday, March 28, 2021, 11:59 pm.

Notification of results will occur the week of April 12, 2021.

If selected, artists must confirm acceptance of exhibition by April 19, 2021.
