COALITION HIGHLIGHTS

Local Park Support – Coalition members are providing support to Middleport, OH to create a park. It will feature a sitting area and small water fountain feature to encourage active living within the community and county alike. The park will be named Farmer's Bank Park.

Micro-Market - A mini-fridge was purchased by the Creating Healthy Communities (CHC) grant to incorporate a healthy micro market for the Meigs County Health Department. Currently, staff and clients do not have access to healthy food or beverage options. A healthy Food and Beverage Policy will be designed and implemented at the health department. The health department staff will sell water and healthy food items, such as vegetables to staff and clients alike.

Greenhouse support - The Creating Healthy Communities (CHC) grant purchased a greenhouse, that is being implemented at the Mid-Valley Christian School in Middleport, OH. The grant is also purchasing vegetables to begin the growing season. The school will use the greenhouse to extend the gardening season, and further gain access to healthy local produce. The students will also be selling their produce within the community to increase access to produce within the county, and to ensure sustainability of the garden for years to come.

Community Orchard - CHC grant is purchasing fruit trees and nut bushes to add a small community orchard to the Meigs County Soil and Water Conservation Area. The community will be allowed to have access to the orchard for consumption of edible items. What is not harvested will be left for wildlife consumption.

2018 - \$350.00 received from Farmer's Bank to go towards the purchases needed for the park in Middleport
2018 - \$2,350 Ohio Department of Transportation for Pedestrian master plan project.
