Day 1

If you consider yourself to have adequate housing, thank God and deposit \$1.

For a dining room, deposit 25¢.

15

For the convenience of a microwave oven, deposit 40¢.

22

Deposit 30¢ if you have a dryer.

29

If your home has a security system, deposit 50¢.

2

If you have a roof over your head that doesn't leak, add 50¢.

9

For each closet in your house, deposit 10¢.

16

Enjoy a dishwasher and deposit 35¢.

23

Add 5¢ per window in your house (4¢ if the window is clean).

30

Deposit 25¢ if you have a water heater.

3

If you have rain gutters, deposit 20¢, plus 5¢ for each downspout.

10

For each heat register in your house, deposit 5¢.

17

For each electrical outlet in your house, deposit 3¢.

24

Add 10¢ for each room that is carpeted in your house.

31

What would you sacrifice to give others adequate housing?

4

For each room in your house, deposit 10¢.

11

No trips to the well! Deposit 15¢ for each water faucet.

18

For each light fixture or lamp, deposit 4¢.

25

Add 20¢ for a one-car garage; 40¢ for a two-car garage; 80¢ for a three-car garage.

5

For your living room, deposit 30¢.

12

If you have a pantry deposit 25¢.

19

For each TV, deposit 20¢. Add 25¢ for internet service.

26

Do you recycle garbage? Yes—Add 25¢. No—Add 50¢.

6

For a bathroom, deposit 15¢. Add 25¢ for each additional bathroom.

13

For each refrigerator, deposit 25¢.

20

If you have a garage door opener, deposit 35¢.

27

If you have a fence around your yard, deposit 50¢.

7

For each bedroom, deposit 20¢.

14

If you have a freezer, deposit 35¢.

21

Add 35¢ if you have a washing Machine.

28

Add 20¢ smoke detector.
