Job Openings at Cincinnati Children's

Respiratory Therapist

Responsible for respiratory therapy duties including oxygen administration, application of ventilators, initiation, assessment of, and recommendations for respiratory care services including diagnostic studies under supervision.

Required:

- * Associate's degree in related field or equivalent
- * 0- 2 years of work experience in a related job discipline
- * RT License, Registered RT, Graduate of CoARC approved respiratory care program

Pharmacy Technician

Responsible for assisting with medication profile reviews for drug incompatibilities, typing of prescription labels, prescription packaging, handling of purchase records, and inventory control, and may dispense drugs to patients under the supervision of a registered pharmacist.

Required:

- * High school diploma or equivalent
- * Certified via Pharmacy Technician Certification Board (PTCB) or eligible for certification
- * Registered with Ohio Board of Pharmacy as a Registered Pharmacy Technician.
- * ASHP accredited program graduate OR licensed as a Pharmacy Intern OR 1 year of pharmacy related experience
