Official Cherokee Strip Parade Rules & Regulations

1. **No candy or other articles may be thrown during the parade from your vehicle or float.** You may walk alongside of your float by the curb and hand out these items to the spectators.
2. You will be provided two numbered signs that must be placed on the front left and front right of your entry indicating your place in the parade line-up. A banner or sign with the name of your organization in front of your entry would be helpful, but not required.
3. Commercial and Non-profit float entries will be judged as follows: 25 points per category. 75 points total.
Categories are: **Design:** Creativity, care in presentation & construction; **Spirit:** Participants enthusiasm & crowd involvement; **General Appearance:** Overall quality and appeal .
4. The winning floats will be announced from the Courthouse Gazebo following the completion of the parade.
5. There will be no parking permitted in any of the line-up areas.

Applications must be turned in by August 31, 2024
