#### Project Overview and Benefits

This crucial project will help the West Avenue neighborhood stay dry and remain a walkable, active community for many years to come. This design-build project includes underground improvements, installing a pump station and raising the elevation of the roadway to minimize street flooding. It will complete the previous work performed throughout the West Avenue neighborhood.

#### What's New

Construction is scheduled to begin in the spring of 2020. Additional scope of work was added to the contract such as developing a comprehensive stormwater drainage model, and includes a well and structure to the pump station to enhance the water treatment process. This additional work must be performed before construction can begin in the neighborhood.

#### Ongoing Activities

- Continuing to develop construction plans
- Conducting one-on-one meetings with building representatives in the segments where construction is scheduled to start first. Scheduling for these meetings just recently commenced. We will continue reaching out to building representatives in the areas of first impact.
- Working with agencies to obtain all necessary permits

#### Next Steps

Coordination with city departments and agencies will continue to finalize the construction plans and secure permits.



Future pre-construction activities are anticipated such as marking locations of utilities, bringing equipment to the area and installing work zone signs.

The team is also hosting Open House sessions on Fridays between 10 a.m. and noon. Check your email for reminders.
