


The Miraculous 54-Day Novena Rosary

(Thanksgiving part- Sept 11- Oct 7)



The Glorious Mysteries

Leader:

Hail! Queen of the Most Holy Rosary, / my Mother Mary, /hail! /At your feet I humbly pray / and offer you a **crown of royal-purple roses**,/ to honor you for your glories. / Each ten bound together,/ recalling to you a glorious mystery, / with my thanksgiving for a particular grace:

We ask our Lord to renew and abundantly bless St Antoninus Church, especially in this sacred time of our Triple Jubilee. May His merciful blessing overflow into the lives of all people—throughout the Church and across the world.

Let us also pray for our personal intentions . Say this quietly in your heart.

Leader:

In the **27 days of thanksgiving** pray: *(Sept 11- Oct 7)*

O Holy Queen, / dispenser of God's graces / and mother of all who invoke your holy name. / Do not look upon my gift and fail to see its binding. / As you graciously receive my gift, / I kindly implore you to receive my thanksgiving; / from your bounty you have granted me the favor I so trustingly sought

Opening Rosary Prayers:

Leader

The Apostle's Creed

I believe in God, / the Father Almighty, / Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, / who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, / born of the Virgin Mary, / suffered under Pontius Pilate,/ was crucified, died and was buried;/ He descended into hell; / on the third day He rose again from the dead;/ He ascended into heaven, / and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty; / from there He will come to judge the living and the dead.

Assistant

I believe in the Holy Spirit, / the Holy Catholic Church, / the communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins, / the resurrection of the body, / and life everlasting.

Leader

Our Father

Our Father, Who art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy Name. Thy Kingdom come. Thy Will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven.

Assistant

Give us this day our daily bread. / And forgive us our trespasses, / as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, / but deliver us from evil. Amen.

Leader

Hail Mary- 3 x

Hail Mary, full of grace, / the Lord is with thee; / Blessed art thou among women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.

Assistant

Holy Mary, Mother of God, / pray for us sinners, / now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

Leader

Glory Be

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Assistant

As it was in the beginning, / is now, / and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

Leader or together

O my Jesus, / forgive us our sins, / save us from the fires of hell, / and lead all souls to Heaven, / especially those in most need of Your Mercy".

Leader or Assistant or together

Song- "O Mary conceived without sin" or "Ave Maria"

Leader

First Glorious Mystery – The Resurrection of Jesus Christ

Very early on the first day of the week, just after sunrise, they were on their way to the tomb and they asked each other, "Who will roll the stone away from the entrance of the tomb?"

But when they looked up, they saw that the stone, which was very large, had been rolled away. As they entered the tomb, they saw a young man dressed in a white robe sitting on the right side, and they were alarmed.

"Don't be alarmed," he said. "You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid him. But go, tell his disciples and Peter, 'He is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him, just as he told you.'" Mark 16:2-13.

Prayer

Glorious Mother Mary, as we meditate on the Mystery of the Resurrection of Our Lord, when, on the morning of the third day after His death and burial, He arose from the dead and appeared as the risen God to you and His disciples, and filled your heart with unspeakable joy, we humbly pray...

Leader leads the following, Assistant responds

1 Our Father, 10 Hail Mary's, 1 Glory Be and 1 "O My Jesus"

Leader or Assistant or together

Song- "O Mary conceived without sin" or "Ave Maria"

Leader:

Glorious Mother, I bind these royal-purple roses with a petition for the grace of faith / and lay this bouquet at your feet.

Assistant:

Second Glorious Mystery – Ascension of the Lord

"...You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witness in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." When he had said this, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and the cloud took him from their sight. While they were looking intently at the sky as he was going, suddenly two men dressed in white garments stood beside them. They said, "Men of Galilee, why are you standing there looking at the sky? This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven will return in the same way as you have seen him going into heaven." (Acts 1:8-11)

Leader:

Prayer

Glorious Mother, as we meditate on the Mystery of the Ascension, when your divine Son, after forty days on earth after the Resurrection, went to Mount Olivet accompanied by His disciples, where they adored Him, / after which He promised to remain with them until the end of the world; then, extending His pierced hands over them in a last blessing, He ascended into heaven, we humbly pray...

Assistant leads the following, Leader responds

1 Our Father, 10 Hail Mary's, 1 Glory Be and 1 "O My Jesus"

Assistant or Leader, or together

Song- “O Mary conceived without sin” or “Ave Maria

Leader:

Glorious Mother, I bind these royal-purple roses with a petition for the grace of desire for Heaven / and lay this bouquet at your feet.

Leader:

Third Glorious Mystery – The Descent of the Holy Spirit

And when the time of Pentecost was fulfilled, they were all in one place together. And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were. Then there appeared to them tongues as a fire, that parted and came to rest on each one of them.

(Acts 2:1-3)

Assistant:

Prayer

Glorious Mother Mary, as we meditate on the Mystery of the Descent of the Holy Spirit, when, the Apostles being assembled in the upper room, the Holy Spirit descended upon them in the form of fiery tongues, inflaming the hearts of the Apostles with the fire of divine love, anointing them with boldness and courage to go and preach the Good News, we humbly pray...

Leader leads the following, Assistant responds

1 Our Father, 10 Hail Mary's, 1 Glory Be and 1 “O My Jesus”

Leader or Assistant or together

Song- “O Mary conceived without sin” or “Ave Maria”

Leader:

Glorious Mother, I bind these royal-purple roses with a petition for the grace of receiving the Holy Spirit and lay this bouquet at your feet.

Assistant:

Fourth Glorious Mystery – The Assumption of Our Blessed Mother into Heaven

And Mary said, “My soul magnifies the Lord,/ and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior,/ for he has looked with favor on the lowliness of his servant. Surely, from

now on / all generations will call me blessed; / for the Mighty One has done great things for me, / and holy is his name (Luke 1:46-55)

Leader:

Prayer

Glorious Mother Mary, as we meditate on the Mystery of your Assumption into Heaven, when upon your death, your Son, for whom your virginal body was His first tabernacle, took your body and soul into Heaven, amidst the acclaims of the angels and saints, we humbly pray...

Assistant leads the following, Leader responds

1 Our Father, 10 Hail Mary's, 1 Glory Be and 1 "O My Jesus"

Leader or Assistant or together

Song- "O Mary conceived without sin" or "Ave Maria"

Assistant:

Glorious Mother, I bind these royal-purple roses with a petition for the grace of true devotion to you, dear mother, / and lay this bouquet at your feet.

Leader:

Fifth Glorious Mystery – The Coronation of Our Blessed Mother Mary

God's temple in heaven was opened, and the ark of his covenant could be seen in the temple. A great sign appeared in the sky / a woman clothed with the sun / with the moon under her feet, / and on her head a crown of 12 stars.

(Revelation 11:19a; 12:1)

Assistant:

Prayer

Glorious Mother Mary, as we meditate on the Mystery of your Coronation in Heaven, when, upon being taken up, you were triply crowned as the August Queen of Heaven by God the Father as His beloved daughter, by God the Son as His dearest mother, and by God the Holy Spirit as His chosen spouse; the most perfect adorer of the Blessed Trinity, pleading our cause as our most powerful and merciful mother and intercessor, through you, we humbly pray...

Leader leads the following, Assistant responds

1 Our Father, 10 Hail Mary's, 1 Glory Be and 1 "O My Jesus".

Leader or Assistant or together

Song- “O Mary conceived without sin” or “Ave Maria

Leader:

Glorious Mother, I bind these royal-purple roses with a petition for the grace of trust in your intercession / and lay this bouquet at your feet.

NOTE: Before “Hail Holy Queen”, proceed first to the Spiritual Communion (following)

Closing Prayers

Leader:

Spiritual Communion

My Jesus, / really present in the most Holy Sacrament of the altar, / since I cannot now receive you under the Sacramental Veil, / I beseech you, / with a heart full of love and longing, / to come spiritually into my soul / through the immaculate heart of Your most Holy Mother, and abide with me forever.

Leader:

In the 27 days of thanksgiving pray: (Sept 11- Oct 7)

Sweet Mother Mary, / I offer you this Spiritual Communion / to bind my bouquets in a wreath to place upon your brow / in thanksgiving for this petition:

We ask our Lord to renew and abundantly bless St Antoninus Church, especially in this sacred time of our Triple Jubilee. May His merciful blessing overflow into the lives of all people—throughout the Church and across the world.

Hail Mary, full of grace, / the Lord is with thee; / Blessed art thou among women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.

Assistant: Holy Mary, Mother of God, / pray for us sinners, / now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

Leader:

Hail Holy Queen

Hail, Holy Queen, / Mother of mercy/ Our life, our sweetness, and our hope. / To thee do we cry, / poor banished children of Eve, to thee do we send up our sighs, /

mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. / Turn then, most gracious advocate, thine eyes of mercy toward us; / and after this our exile, / show unto us the blessed fruit of Thy womb Jesus. / O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin. Mary.

Leader:

Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God.

Assistant:

That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Leader

Let us Pray. O God, / whose only begotten Son /, by His life, death, and resurrection, / has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life. / Grant, we beseech Thee, / that in meditating upon these mysteries / of the most Holy Rosary / of the Blessed Virgin Mary, / we may imitate what they contain / and obtain what they promise, / through the same Christ our Lord.

Amen.

Assistant

Memorare:

Remember, / O most gracious Virgin Mary, / that never was it known, / that anyone who fled to Your protection, / implored Your help / or sought Your intercession / was left unaided. / Inspired by this confidence, / we fly unto You, / O Virgin of Virgins, our Mother. / To You do we come, / before You we stand, / sinful and sorrowful, / O mother of the Word Incarnate, / despise not our petitions, / but in Your mercy, hear and answer us. / Amen

Leader:

St. Michael the Archangel.

Saint Michael the Archangel, / defend us in battle; / be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil. / May God rebuke him, / we humbly pray; / and do Thou, / O Prince of the Heavenly Host, / by the power of God, / cast into hell Satan / and all the evil spirits / who prowl about the world / seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.

Leader leads, Assistants responds

Most Sacred Heart of Jesus... **have mercy on us. (3x)**

Immaculate Heart of Mary... **pray for us**

Queen of the Most Holy Rosary... **pray for us**

St Joseph... **pray for us**
