LOOK UP: TWO GIANTS GRACE THE STAINED GLASS WINDOWS ON BOTH SIDES OF JESUS.

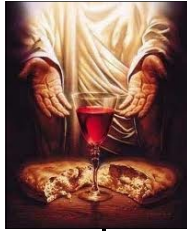
