THE MONTH OF JUNE IS DEDICATED TO THE SACRED HEART.

What a debt of reparation we owe to the Heart of our Savior, the Second Person of the Trinity, the Son of God, the Creator of the Universe, our Lord, the Just Judge, the Author & the Finisher of our Faith, the King of the Universe, our Bridegroom. On May 10, the patronal feast of St. Antoninus, we were treated to that kind of reverential & recollected attention as Fr. Leo Camuratie, O.P. celebrated a Traditional Mass in the Dominican rite, the way it was celebrated here for the 100 years the Dominicans served this parish. About 50 showed up that Tuesday at noon to bask in a heightened sense of Our Lord's Presence. A beautiful booklet with the special readings for that feast along with the flow of a Latin Mass was provided & the altar arranged in the traditional way, with the celebrant facing east as it is from the east that the Lord will return.

IT'S COMING: SET ASIDE THE DAY TO PRAY & MAKE REPARATION.

The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart is celebrated 19 days after Pentecost & the Feast was established by Pope Pius IX to be celebrated the Friday after Corpus Christi, that day being June 24th this year. The devotion existed from ancient times & was renewed by the revelations to St. Marguerite Mary Alacoque in the 17th century. It revealed the First Friday devotions that we do till this day. She shared what she was shown:

He (Christ) showed me that it was His greatest desire of being loved by men & of withdrawing them from the path of ruin that made Him form the design of manifesting His Heart to men, with all the treasures of love, of mercy, of grace, of sanctification & salvation which it contains in order that those who desire to render Him & procure for Him all the honor & love possible might themselves be abundantly enriched with those divine treasures of which His Heart is the source.

If ever there was a time to take refuge in His Sacred Heart, it is NOW. We all know what the world will be sickly celebrating in the month of June & we must quietly & firmly go about honoring the only One Who is worthy of all honor & praying for all who have lost sight of that. This is crucial for where we will spend eternity is at stake for all of us & that could come sooner than we think for great numbers in this world gone mad. War claims many victims as does tyranny.



So hide yourself in His Sacred Heart & in so doing Pope Benedict XVI tells us: We will be able to understand better what it means to know God's love in Jesus Christ, to experience Him, keeping our gaze fixed on Him to the point that we live entirely on the experience of His love, so we can subsequently witness it to others.

Have YOU experienced His love? Come & adore Him & fix your gaze upon Him & just be & allow Him to plunge you in His love that He has for the totally unique YOU. There will never be another YOU & He wants You to know how much He loves You.

AND THE FEAST THAT FOLLOWS IS THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY.

This is celebrated the very next day, June 25th as we pause to venerate the one who agreed to bear the holiness of God into this world in order to save it. Conceived without sin, prepared from all eternity by her Creator to be the one who would bear the Redeemer IF she agreed to it. So great is His reverence for her that all the graces He wants to pour out on the world, go through her to us, her children. We venerate her & we worship her Son. As He said at later Fatima revelations, He wants His mother to be honored. After all, she will be the one to humiliate the head of the evil one in the final victory when her Immaculate Heart will triumph. For that we wait with eager anticipation as his antics in the world are getting more & more onerous & violent as he knows his time is short.

So draw as close to God as you can get in this world gone mad with all the attacks of the evil one.
