

Then our course is not directed by the Holy Spirit, but by ourselves, by our reason which clings to its own judgment unconformed to the judgment of God; it is directed by our will, inordinate self-love & caprice. Hence, although in a state of grace, we hardly live under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit.
