*Whoever today supports the continuation of this liturgy is put in the Index; all tolerance in this regard is vanquished. I don't understand in the least, to be frank, why there is such subjection to this intolerance on the part of many of my fellow bishops, which seems to be an obligatory tribute to the spirit of the times & which to appears to counteract without any comprehensible reason, the necessary process of internal reconciliation in the Church.* (Cardinal Joseph Ratzinger, God in the Word. San Paolo, 2001)
