LISTEN UP WORLD!

There is only one King & He is the Creator, Sustainer & Ruler of all. And time of this era is coming to a close & all must decide whom they will serve & where. And they need to decide quickly & we need to make the urgency of the time known to them & direct them to the sacraments, especially Baptism. Why is that so important? *Before our baptism, we were sanctuaries of the devil; but after our baptism, we merited the privilege of being temples of Christ. At our first birth, we were vessels of God's wrath (for we were born into the domain of the evil one, earth, & thus citizens of his kingdom) Reborn, through baptism we became vessels of His mercy. Our first birth brought death to us, but the second restored us to life.* (St. Carsarius of Arles)

What a privilege it is to be Catholic! But we need to practice our faith vigorously for the battle for souls has ramped up as the evil one knows his time is short.

RULERS OF THE WORLD...WAKE UP!

AS THE WORLD CRUMBLES AROUND US...


