

The Miraculous 54-Day Novena Rosary

(Thanksgiving part- Sept 11- Oct 7)

The Luminous Mysteries

Leader:

Hail! Queen of the Most Holy Rosary, my Mother Mary, hail!

At your feet I humbly pray and offer you a **crown of bright-yellow roses**, in remembrance of the mysteries of light manifested in your divine Son. Each ten bound together, recalling to you a luminous mystery, with my thanksgiving for a particular grace:

We ask our Lord to renew and abundantly bless St Antoninus Church, especially in this sacred time of our Triple Jubilee. May His merciful blessing overflow into the lives of all people—throughout the Church and across the world.

Let us also pray for our personal intentions . Say this quietly in your heart.

Leader:

In the **27 days of thanksgiving** pray: *(Sept 11- Oct 7)*

O Holy Queen, / dispenser of God's graces / and mother of all who invoke your holy name. / Do not look upon my gift and fail to see its binding. / As you graciously receive my gift, / I kindly implore you to receive my thanksgiving; / from your bounty you have granted me the favor I so trustingly sought.

Opening Rosary Prayers:

Leader:

The Apostle's Creed

I believe in God, / the Father Almighty, / Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, / who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, / born of the Virgin Mary, / suffered under Pontius Pilate, / was crucified, died and was buried; / He descended into hell; / on the third day He rose again from the dead; / He ascended into heaven, / and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty; / from there He will come to judge the living and the dead.

Assistant

I believe in the Holy Spirit, / the Holy Catholic Church, / the communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins, / the resurrection of the body, / and life everlasting.

Leader:

Our Father



Our Father, Who art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy Name. Thy Kingdom come. Thy Will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven.

Assistant

Give us this day our daily bread. / And forgive us our trespasses, / as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, / but deliver us from evil. Amen.

Leader:

Hail Mary- 3 x

Hail Mary, full of grace, / the Lord is with thee; / Blessed art thou among women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.

Assistant

Holy Mary, Mother of God, / pray for us sinners, / now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

Leader:

Glory Be

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Assistant

As it was in the beginning, / is now, / and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

Leader or together

O my Jesus, / forgive us our sins, / save us from the fires of hell, / and lead all souls to Heaven, / especially those in most need of Your Mercy.

Leader or Assistant or together

Song- "O Mary conceived without sin" or "Ave Maria"

Leader

The First Luminous Mystery: THE BAPTISM OF JESUS IN THE JORDAN

And lo, a voice from heaven, saying, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased." (Matthew 3:17)

Assistant

Prayer:

O Mother of the Eucharist, as we meditate on the Mystery of the Baptism of Jesus in the Jordan River, when your Son Jesus, who was without sin, but became the 'lamb of God' and took upon Himself all our sins to redeem us, insisted on being baptized by His cousin John... and the sky opened and the Holy Spirit came down

to Him like a dove and a voice from Heaven said, "This is my beloved Son in whom I am well pleased", we humbly pray...

Leader leads the following, Assistant responds

1 Our Father, 10 Hail Mary's, 1 Glory Be and 1 "O My Jesus"

Leader or Assistant or together

Song- "O Mary conceived without sin" or "Ave Maria"

Leader:

O Mother of the Eucharist, I bind these bright-yellow roses with a petition for the grace of openness to the Holy Spirit and humbly lay this bouquet at your feet.

Assistant:

The Second Luminous Mystery THE WEDDING AT CANA

And Jesus said to her, "O woman, what have you to do with me? My hour has not yet come." ... His mother said to the servants: "Do whatever he tells you." (John 2:4-5)

Leader:

Prayer:

O Mother of the Eucharist, as we meditate on the Mystery of the First Miracle of Jesus at the Wedding Feast at Cana, when at your urging, your Son performed the first of His many miracles by changing water into wine in order to help a couple celebrate their marriage, we humbly pray...

Assistant leads the following, Leader responds

1 Our Father, 10 Hail Mary's, 1 Glory Be and 1 "O My Jesus"

Leader or Assistant or together

Song- "O Mary conceived without sin" or "Ave Maria"

Assistant:

O Mother of the Eucharist, I bind these bright-yellow roses with a petition for the grace of manifestation through faith and humbly lay this bouquet at your feet.

Leader:

The Third Luminous Mystery THE PROCLAMATION OF THE KINGDOM OF GOD

*"All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."
Matthew 28:18-20*

Assistant

Prayer:

O Mother of the Eucharist, as we meditate on the Mystery of the Proclamation of the Kingdom of God, when your Son revealed that the reign of God has already begun "within us" and that we are called to conversion and forgiveness, praying "Your Kingdom come, your will be done, on Earth as it is in Heaven," we humbly pray...

Leader leads the following, Assistant responds

1 Our Father, 10 Hail Mary's, 1 Glory Be and 1 "O My Jesus"

Leader or Assistant or together

Song- "O Mary conceived without sin" or "Ave Maria"

Leader:

O Mother of the Eucharist, I bind these bright-yellow roses with a petition for the grace of trust in God and humbly lay this bouquet at your feet.

Assistant:

The Fourth Luminous Mystery THE TRANSFIGURATION OF JESUS

*"And a voice came out of the cloud, saying, "This is my Son, my Chosen; listen!"
(Luke 9:35)*

Leader

Prayer:

O Mother of the Eucharist, as we meditate on the Mystery of the Transfiguration, when your Son revealed His glory to His three disciples, appearing on a mountain with Moses and Elijah, His face shining like the sun and a voice from heaven proclaiming, "This is my Son...Listen to him", we humbly pray....

Assistant leads the following, Leader responds

1 Our Father, 10 Hail Mary's, 1 Glory Be and 1 "O My Jesus"

Leader or Assistant or together

Song- "O Mary conceived without sin" or "Ave Maria"

Assistant:

O Mother of the Eucharist, I bind these bright-yellow roses with a petition for the grace of desire for holiness and humbly lay this bouquet at your feet.

Leader:

The Fifth Luminous Mystery THE INSTITUTION OF THE EUCHARIST

"Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of man and drink his blood, you have no life in you..." (John 6:53)

Assistant

Prayer:

O Mother of the Eucharist, as we meditate on the Mystery of the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus in the Eucharist, we thank you for your fiat that allowed the fruit of your womb to become the heavenly food that we eat, allowing us to embrace God's will, face life's challenges and continue on the road to Heaven, we humbly pray.....

Leader leads the following, Assistant responds

1 Our Father, 10 Hail Mary's, 1 Glory Be and 1 "O My Jesus" Jesus".

Leader or Assistant or together

Song- "O Mary conceived without sin" or "Ave Maria"

Leader:

O Mother of the Eucharist, I bind these bright-yellow roses with a petition for the grace of adoration of the Eucharist with awe and great reverence and humbly lay this bouquet at your feet.

NOTE: Before "Hail Holy Queen", proceed first to the Spiritual Communion (following)

Closing Prayers

Leader:

Spiritual Communion

My Jesus, / really present in the most Holy Sacrament of the altar, / since I cannot now receive you under the Sacramental Veil, / I beseech you, / with a heart full of love and longing, / to come spiritually into my soul / through the immaculate heart of Your most Holy Mother, and abide with me forever.

Leader:

In the 27 days of thanksgiving pray: (Sept 11- Oct 7)

O Mother of the Eucharist, / I offer you this Spiritual Communion / to bind my bouquets in a wreath to place upon your brow / in thanksgiving for this petition: **We ask our Lord to renew and abundantly bless St Antoninus Church, especially in this sacred time of our Triple Jubilee. May His merciful blessing overflow into the lives of all people—throughout the Church and across the world.**

Leader:

Hail Mary, full of grace, / the Lord is with thee; / Blessed art thou among women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.

Assistant: Holy Mary, Mother of God, / pray for us sinners, / now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

Leader:

Hail Holy Queen

Hail, Holy Queen, / Mother of mercy/ Our life, our sweetness, and our hope. / To thee do we cry, / poor banished children of Eve, to thee do we send up our sighs, / mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. / Turn then, most gracious advocate, thine eyes of mercy toward us; / and after this our exile, / show unto us the blessed fruit of Thy womb Jesus. / O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin. Mary.

Leader:

Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God.

Assistant:

That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Leader

Let us Pray. O God, / whose only begotten Son /, by His life, death, and resurrection, / has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life. / Grant, we beseech Thee, / that in meditating upon these mysteries / of the most Holy Rosary / of the Blessed Virgin Mary, / we may imitate what they contain / and obtain what they promise, / through the same Christ our Lord.
Amen.

Assistant

Memorare:

Remember, / O most gracious Virgin Mary, / that never was it known, / that anyone who fled to Your protection, / implored Your help / or sought Your intercession / was left unaided. / Inspired by this confidence, / we fly unto You, / O Virgin of Virgins, our Mother. / To You do we come, / before You we stand, / sinful and sorrowful, / O mother of the Word Incarnate, / despise not our petitions, / but in Your mercy, hear and answer us. / Amen

Leader:

St. Michael the Archangel.

Saint Michael the Archangel, / defend us in battle; / be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil. / May God rebuke him, / we humbly pray; / and do Thou, / O Prince of the Heavenly Host, / by the power of God, / cast into hell Satan / and all the evil spirits / who prowl about the world / seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.

Leader leads, Assistants responds

Immaculate Heart of Mary... **pray for us**

Queen of the Most Holy Rosary... **pray for us**
