### **LET'S GET REAL.**

We must admit realistically & with profound suffering that Christians today feel lost, confused, perplexed & also disappointed: there are diffused ideas in contrast with the truth as revealed & always taught; there are diffused true & proper heresies in the field of dogma & morals...the liturgy has been altered; immersed in intellectual & moral relativism & therefore in permissiveness, Christians are tempted by atheism, by agnostics, by a vaguely preached illuminism & by a sociological Christianity, deprived of definite dogmas & moral objectivity. It is necessary to begin all over again. (Pope John Paul II L'Osservatore Romano, Feb. 7, 1981)

### **HERE IS THE REMEDY AGAINST THIS EVIL....THE ROSARY.**

Pray! Pray! & ask nothing more. Entrust all the rest to the Mother of God. We have to be prepared to suffer, before long (Now) great trials will require of us the disposition to sacrifice even our life in total submissions to Christ & for Christ. Through your prayers & mine, it is still possible to diminish this trial, but it is no longer possible to avert it, because only in this manner can the Church be effectively renewed. How many times has the renewal of the Church been brought about by blood! It will not be different this time.
