

We have been given every enticement to amend our lives. We have been called by God & now it is up to us to return to Him while we still have the time & the One Who is ready to receive us. For if we renounce sinful pleasures & practice self control by refusing to yield to our evil desires, we shall share in the mercy of Christ.

You must know, however, that the day of judgment, like a flaming furnace, is already approaching. Sun, moon & stars will be consumed & the whole earth will become like lead melting in fire. And what each man has done, whether openly or in secret, will then be brought to light. Therefore, a very good way of atoning for our sins is by being generous to the poor. Fasting is better than prayer, but almsgiving surpasses both for love covers a multitude of sins. Nevertheless prayer delivers the souls from death if it proceeds from a good conscience.

To make sure that none of us is lost, **WE MUST REPENT FROM THE BOTTOM OF OUR HEARTS.** Since we have been commanded to go out & rescue idolators & to instruct them, is it not even more important to save souls who already know God?

If we are all to be saved, we shall have to help one another & support the weak in their struggle to live a good life. When one of us does wrong, it is for the others to warn him & persuade him of his error. (Second Century Homily)

At our first birth, we were vessels of God's wrath; reborn we became vessels of His mercy. Our first birth brought death to us, but our second restored us to life.


Before our baptism, we were sanctuaries of the devil, but after our baptism, we merited the privilege of being temples of Christ. And if we think more carefully about the meaning of our salvation, we shall realize that we are indeed living & true temples of God. God does not dwell only in structures fashioned by human hands, in homes of wood & stone, but rather He dwells principally in the soul made according to His own image & fashioned by His own hand. Therefore, the temple of God is holy & you are that temple.

When Christ came, He banished the devil from our hearts in order to build in them a temple for Himself. Let us therefore do what we can with His help, so that our evil deeds will not deface that temple. For whoever does evil, does injury to Christ. In His mercy we have merited the privilege of being the house of God. Let us not destroy the living temples of God in ourselves by works of evil. Whenever we come to church, we must prepare our hearts to be as beautiful as we expect the church to be. Do you wish to find the church immaculately clean? (Come & help it be so!) Then do not soil your soul with the filth of sins. (St. Caesarius of Arles)

FOR WHAT SORT OF LOVE OF CHRIST IS IT TO FEAR HIS COMING?

Do we not have to blush with shame? We love Him yet we fear His coming. Are we really certain that we love Him? Or do we love our sins more? He will come whether we wish it or not. He will come, you know not when & provided he finds you prepared, your ignorance of the time of His coming will not be held against you. (St. Augustine)
