WHAT THE BRIDEGROOM DID

Praying for His bride (the Church), the Son said to the Father: *I want them to be one with us, even as you & I are one.*

And so the Bridegroom is one with the Father & one with the bride. Whatever He found in His bride alien to her own nature He took from her & nailed to the Cross when He bore her sins & destroyed them on the tree. He received from her & clothed Himself in what was hers by nature & gave her what belonged to Him as God. He destroyed what was diabolical, took to Himself what was human & conferred on her what was divine. So that all that belonged to the bride was shared in by the Bridegroom & He Who had done no wrong & on Whose lips was found no deceit could say: *Have pity on Me, Lord for I am weak.* Thus sharing as He did in the bride's weakness, the Bridegroom made His own her cry of distress & gave His bride all that was His. Therefore she, too, has the prerogative of receiving the confession of sin & the power to forgive sin, which is the reason for the command: *Go, show yourself to the priest.* (Blessed Isaac of Stella)

GO NOW TO THE PRIEST IN CONFESSION.

And unburden yourselves of the weight of sin now so you will not be accountable for it before the Judge when you face Him. Ask the Holy Spirit to enlighten you as to what you need to repent of & confess. Be still to hear what it is He wants you to hear & rectify. Write it down as it comes to you & seek absolution for it as soon as possible & receive the grace to persevere & press on until He calls us home.

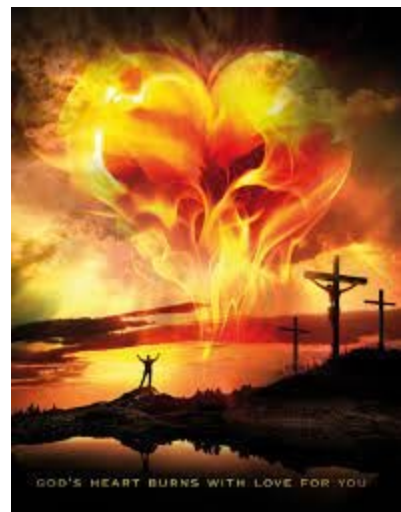
EPHPHATHA...BE OPENED!

Be opened to the Truth & heed it. Pray to the Father that His will be done here on earth as it is in heaven. Free yourselves from the distractions of this world & focus on the only reason for being here & that is to know, love & serve Him in this world until we can rejoin Him in our heavenly home. Heaven beckons but the evil one is pulling out all the stops to keep us from drawing close to & following Our Savior. We must be extremely focused on & in agreement with the will of God for each of us to enter His peace no matter what the circumstances around us are.

Even the most intimate bonds of friendship & the closest affinity of minds cannot truly lay claim to this peace if they are not in agreement with the will of God. Alliances based on evil desires, covenants of crime & pacts of vice (which aptly describes our world today) all lie outside this scope of peace. Love of the world cannot be reconciled with love of God & the man who does not separate himself from the children of this generation cannot join the company of the sons of God.

But those who keep God ever in their hearts & never depart & never dissent from the eternal law are the peacemakers & are rightly given the title "sons of God", "coheirs with Christ". And this is the reward they will receive for their love of God & neighbor: when their struggle with all temptation is finally over, there will be no further adversities to suffer or scandal to fear; but they will rest in the peace of God undisturbed through Our Lord Who lives & reigns with the Father & the Holy Spirit forever & ever. (St. Leo the Great)
