Nothing impeded His entry into the Upper Room. There are no barriers to His glorified body. Would that be the case for all our hearts. He has free entry but too often finds the door of our hearts closed & He keeps knocking for He will not violate our free will. He will do anything to get the attention of His children including a great shaking of the earth to wake us up to signal the end of this age & the beginning of a new one that requires great purification as the new age ushers in His Kingdom on earth as it is in heaven. He needs us to be pure in heart, mind, body & soul & on this Divine Mercy Sunday, He is granting us the grace to experience a new Baptism in which our sins are forgiven & the punishment due them remitted. Avail yourself of the channels of His amazing grace, the sacraments, especially Confession & Eucharist on this holy day.

My mercy is greater than your sins & those of the entire world. Who can measure the extent of My goodness? For I have descended from heaven to earth for YOU. I have allowed Myself to be nailed to a cross for YOU. I let My Sacred Heart be pierced with a lance, thus opening wide the source of mercy for YOU. Come, then, with trust to draw graces from this fountain. I NEVER REJECT A CONTRITE HEART. Your misery has disappeared in the depths of My mercy. Do not argue with Me about your wretchedness. You will give Me pleasure if you will hand over to Me all your troubles & griefs.

All the graces of this day are accessible to us this day...ASK for them.

Place yourself in the Upper Room with the apostles & receive His peace which will enable us, as it did them, to endure pain & suffering for His sake & there is even a mysterious soul joy in the middle of the suffering as we, the bride are following our bridegroom to & through the cross. What is on the other side is indescribable. So let us press on, steeped in the promise of our entry into His Kingdom if we but follow & obey Him. And above all, unlike Adam & Eve we need to TRUST Him. *My child, all your sins have not wounded My heart as painfully as your present lack of trust does; that after so many efforts of My love & mercy you should still doubt My goodness.* (Diary 1486)

IT'S LIKE BEING BAPTIZED ALL OVER AGAIN!

Enter into this feast deeply & avail yourself of the chance to be like you were on the day of your Baptism when you became a child of God & the evil one was kicked out of your soul & the Holy Spirit moved in. On this day after years of living & being tested & falling many times, we have the chance to be pardoned of all the sins we bring to confession & all the temporal punishment due those accumulated sins is remitted & you are like a newborn in Christ again. If an earth quake hits or a tsunami overwhelms us or some lunatic presses the button unleashing nuclear warheads, on this day which we have so carefully embraced, we would go straight to heaven.

In 2002 Pope John Paul II wanting us to make the most of this incredible feast granted a plenary indulgence for those who go to Confession, receive the Eucharist & pray for the intentions of the Pope on the second Sunday of Easter, Divine Mercy Sunday in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers & devotion held in honor of the Divine Mercy or who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the Tabernacle, recite the Our Father & the Creed & adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g., Jesus I trust in You) will receive a plenary indulgence. And we all need that NOW!

Speak to the world about My mercy...it is a sign for the end time. After it will come the day of justice (848). You will prepare the world for My final coming (429) tell the souls about this great mercy of Mine, because the awful day, that day of My justice is near.(965)

We are beginning to experience the beginning of the onslaught of that day of His justice.

Get your souls ready & if have done all you could to do that, then TRUST Him.
