**THE POWER OF THE CHAPLET:** *Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death. When you say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father & the dying person, not as the just judge but as the merciful Savior.* (Diary 1731) The chaplet & image will protect your loved ones on their deathbed against the devils who are most aggressive at that time.

### **WANT TO START OVER WITH A TOTALLY CLEAN SLATE?**

Want to be as innocent before God as you were when you were baptized, where all sin is removed along with the punishment due to sin? That is the power of Baptism which is why Jesus commanded us to go to all the world & baptize them in the Name of the Father & the Son & the Holy Spirit.

TODAY this is your chance to recover that original innocence & purity of soul that make you immediately heaven bound should you expire after the devotions of this day. God's greatest attribute is His mercy & today's feast is His gift to us in these perilous times. He knows what we are up against & His supernatural mercy will vanquish the arrogance & onslaught of the evil one if we but surrender & submit to Jesus, Our Lord & Savior.

We have been preparing for this feast with the Divine Mercy Novena started on Good Friday. We have been praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet daily along with the Rosary. We ponder the Divine Image Jesus gave to St. Faustina which especially represents the 3 great Sacraments. The Red rays represent His blood shed for us & given us in the Eucharist. The White rays represent the cleansing water of Baptism that makes us pure & holy in His sight. The white robe & raised hand represents the priesthood & God forgiving us our sins through His priests. To prepare for this feast we need to make a very serious confession focusing on God's mercy. To receive this great gift of pardon of all sin & punishment, we need to receive worthily Holy Communion on this the day of Divine Mercy.

### **PREPARE THE WORLD FOR MY FINAL COMING.**

*When punishments for sins shall come upon the earth, & your native land shall be in extreme abasement, the only salvation will be hope in Divine Mercy. I shall preserve the cities & homes in which this picture shall be found; I shall protect likewise those persons who shall venerate & have confidence in My Mercy.* (Words of Jesus to Sr. Faustina & Fr. Soposko) Sounds like an apt description of what we are currently experiencing. Our confidence needs to be strong, growing from faith to trust even in the most extenuating circumstances. There is no time to waste.

*Speak to the world about My Mercy. It is a sign for the end times. After it will come the day of justice. You will prepare the world for My final coming. Tell souls about this great mercy of Mine, because the awful day, the day of judgment is near.* (965 in the Diary)

*I am giving them the last hope of salvation, that is, recourse to My Mercy. If they will not adore My Mercy, they will perish for all eternity.*

(Diary 965)

*No one can say there is no hell. Let the sinner know that he will be tortured for all eternity in those senses he*

*made use of to sin.* (Diary 741)

If you haven't gone yet, go to Confession TODAY.

*I Myself am waiting for you there. I am only hidden by the priest. I Myself act in your soul. Make your confession before Me. The person of the priest is for Me only a screen. Never analyze what sort of priest it is that I am making use of; open your soul in confession as you would to Me & I will fill you with My Light.* (Diary 1725)
