**BEHOLD I AM COMING SOON.**

In God's domain there is no space or time, but in our time that could be anytime. So we must be ready at all times. He promised He would not leave us orphans & He hasn't. He is with us literally at every Mass & He indwells us so that we are living tabernacles. During this time leading up to Pentecost, we prepare our hearts & souls to receive Him. First of all we need to want Him & then we need to ask for this greatest gift the Father can give us. Jesus came to prepare the way for Him as the surest vehicle to the heart of the Father. The Spirit in His gentle indwelling *brings knowledge of the future, understanding of the mysteries of faith, insight into the hidden meaning of Scripture & other special gifts.* No intelligent souls want to be citizens of this world, satan's domain, forever..we are only here to get there. *Through the Spirit we become citizens of heaven, we are admitted to the company of angels, we enter into eternal happiness & abide in God. Through the Spirit we acquire a likeness to God & abide in God; indeed we attain what is beyond our most sublime aspirations—we become God* (St. Basil the Great)

So what right minded soul would not want to receive the very Spirit of God? He gives it freely if we both want & ask for it & prepare our hearts to receive it. And the key to receiving Him is humble repentance.

*And the soul bears the fruit of holiness when repentance has made it worthy of receiving the Holy Spirit.* (St. Cyril of Jerusalem.) So use these few days fruitfully, humbly preparing your heart & soul for the very Third Person of the Blessed Trinity.

**GLORY, GLORY, GLORY**

That is what we about to plunge into if we want it & prepare ourselves to receive. Glory belongs to our God but He, in His great love, wants us to share in it. Glory is the force that unites & bonds the Trinity & the unity of the Trinity is so great that it is one...in three...pure mystery. *Now the bond that creates this unity is glory. That the Holy Spirit is called Glory no one can deny if he thinks carefully about the Lord's words: “The glory You gave to Me, I have given to them.” He gave this glory to His disciples when He said to them: “Receive the Holy Spirit.” And though He has always possessed It, even before the world existed, He Himself received this glory when He put on human nature. Then when His human nature had been glorified by the Spirit, the glory of the Spirit was passed on to His disciples ( & us, if we want it!) This is why He said: “The Glory You gave to Me, I have given to them, so that they may be one as we are One. With me in them & You in Me, I want them to be perfectly one.* (St. Gregory of Nyssa)

He ascended & as much as His disciples wanted Him to stay, He knew He had to ascend to His Father, Who, upon receiving the ransom for the world His Son had dutifully paid, would send the Holy Spirit to protect, lead &



anoint the ones His Father had given Him. And He knew that the ones He had come to save would only be able to know & call the Father Abba through the power of the Holy Spirit, Who like the Father & the Son is Love, the Love that would bring them home.

*In place of earth, the Spirit reopens heaven to us & gladly admits us into paradise, giving us even now greater honor than the angels.* (Didymus of Alexandria)
