

Today marks the passing of Fr. Paul Lehman on June 20, 2019. How appropriate this second anniversary falls on Father's Day for Fr. Paul's sacerdotal gift was "fatherhood". All priests are called to be fathers but his gift of fatherhood was especially obvious & experienced by so many of us. His **goodness** attracted us & his solid formation led us in the paths of the faith that were clear & immutable. His life manifested richly the **fruits** of the Holy Spirit. He was **gentle** but firm when it came to the tenets of the faith as handed down by the apostles. He had a great devotion to Mary to whom he consecrated his life & his priesthood. He was **gracious** in dealing with everyone unless challenged on issues of the true faith. His **generosity** & **hospitality** were legendary welcoming all who came to visit or chat or seek counsel at his lake house. Though he hated waiting in lines, he showed great **patience** in counseling & directing seminarians & his parishioners. He loved celebrating Mass & his **joy** reflected his knowledge & appreciation of all that happens at Mass, the greatest drama on the face of the earth. His **kindness** drew people to him & to the Lord he represented & served. He maintained his **peace** in the face of the difficult challenges & even persecutions he faced. He never called attention to himself or to his priesthood to win special favor or standing. He knew Who the real Priest is & he served Him with **humility** & devotion. He was **faithful** to his calling to the end, crossing the finish line of his life with his faith intact & deepened. He knew how to pace himself & exercised **self control** in alternating his ministry with times of rest & reflection that fed the fire of his priestly ministry & saved him from burn out. And then there was the **love** that sustained him, animated him & endowed him to spread it to all he met.
