

The Nine Offices of the Sacred Heart





The prayers of the Nine Offices of the Sacred Heart were derived from and inspired by the revelations of the Sacred Heart to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque. In each of the nine offices, we ask our Blessed Mother and each of the 9 choirs of angels to pray with us, as we adore the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Before we begin the offices, let us invoke the aid of the Choirs of Angels who will be praying with us. According to ancient tradition, the angels are arrayed in a hierarchy of nine ranks or choirs, whose designations are drawn from Scripture.

Invocation of the Nine Choirs of Angels

- O holy **Angels**, / watch over us at all times during this perilous life.
- O holy **Archangels**, / be our guides on the way to heaven.
- O heavenly choir of the **Principalities**,/ govern us in soul and body.
- O mighty **Powers**, / preserve us against the wiles of the demons.
- O celestial **Virtues**, / give us strength and courage in the battle of life.
- O powerful **Dominions**, / obtain for us dominion over the rebellion of our flesh.
- O sacred **Thrones**,/ grant us peace with God and man.
- O brilliant **Cherubim**, / illuminate our minds with heavenly knowledge.
- O burning **Seraphim**, *I* enkindle in our hearts the fire of charity. Amen.

SPIRITUAL DISPOSITION

Leader: It is our care as **Worshippers** to unite our prayers with the prayers which the Sacred Heart of Jesus offers for us in the Blessed Sacrament. We join our tribute of praise to honor the Eternal Father.

Let us all place ourselves in God's presence, striving to feel as a nobody before the Almighty. Let us also strive to acquire a profound feeling of lowliness before the Divine Majesty of God. At this moment, let us unite our worship with that of the Most Pure Heart of Mary and the Choir of Dominions.

MOTIVATION

Leader: As Worshippers, let us consider the Divinity, truly present in the Most Sacred Heart. In the cross, we must see faith; in the wound, hope; in the flames, charity. We must be able to hear also the sweet complaint of Jesus who laments that it is harder to endure the ingratitude of men than the sorrow of His Passion. We must feel the same sorrow of heart as felt by our Lord Jesus who is bitterly grieved because the persons consecrated to His service are so cold to this devotion. "I long to be honored in the Most Holy Sacrament, but I find nobody to satisfy My most ardent desires."

ADORATION BEFORE THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

All: O Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, / grant to me and my fellow **worshippers** and children of Your Divine Heart, / and to all priests, religious and consecrated souls, / the spirit of fervor and holy zeal, / that we may fulfill the obligations of our state of life. Give also to all persons consecrated to Your service, / the grace of ever increasing sanctity, / that they may bring honor to our Mother, the Church, / and pay homage to God in spirit and in truth.

Leader: O Divine Heart, All: Have mercy on us.

Leader: O exalted Choir of Heavenly Dominions, I lift up together with me to the august Heart of Jesus all the good done in the Catholic world and consecrate it to His greater glory. My Jesus, I join with my whole soul in the acts of adoration You offer Your Eternal Father. I love to offer You the loving sentiments / with which You have inspired Mary Most Holy and Your saints / in order to adore and glorify You as You deserve throughout eternity.

All: Amen.

PRACTICE

Leader: It is our care as **Worshippers** to exhibit profound reverence and recollection during Holy Mass. We should allow the Eucharist continue to live in our hearts as we adore the Divine Father. As Worshippers, let us cultivate an awareness of the Presence of God which is the means of attaining a high degree of perfection.



2. Second Office: LOVER

We unite our prayers with the Immaculate Heart of Mary & the Choir of Seraphim

Leader: Romans 8:37-39

No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am sure that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Suggested song: **O Sacred Heart, O Love Divine** (Page 45, #10)

SPIRITUAL DISPOSITION

Leader: It is our task as Lovers to worship Christ in the Holy Eucharist. We must render ourselves worthy of the love of the Sacred Heart by preserving our innocence and purity. We must give ourselves fully to Jesus, if we wish Him to give Himself wholly to us.

MOTIVATION

Leader: As Lovers of the Sacred Heart, let us reflect on the flames with which the Sacred Heart of Jesus burns and how His Heart, radiant as the sun, is surrounded by the Choir of Seraphim who sings: "The love of the Sacred Heart triumphs, exalts and consoles." Let us ponder on the words of Jesus: "I have come to bring fire to the earth, and how I wish it were blazing already." (Lk 12:49)

ADORATION BEFORE THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

All: O Adorable Heart of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, I consecrate to You every moment of my life. My heart, I leave behind with You in this Holy Tabernacle, / so that with the Choir of Seraphim, / I may love You now and forever. I love You,/ O most amiable Heart of Jesus,/ but my love is so cold. / May You make my heart and those of all creatures burn with the fire of Your love.

O Heart of Jesus, / I implore You to grant me the grace / to love You more and more. / Mary, Mother of my Lord and my mother too, / make me love His Heart Divine.

O Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, / divine furnace of the fire of that love which You are so earnest to enkindle on earth, / and which You wish to burn in all hearts. / Grant that our hearts may be consumed in those holy flames.

O Seraphim of the Heavenly Court, / I beseech and conjure You to tell the Author of my life / of my ardent desire to burn and languish with love of Him.

PRACTICE

Leader: Our homage as **Lovers** consists in the fervor of pure affection and in the exactness in love and not of fear. Let us pray especially that the souls of the just may advance in virtue



3. Third Office: VICTIM

We unite our prayers with the Immaculate Heart of Mary & the Choir of Virtues

Leader: Philippians 2:6-8:

(Jesus) though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. And being found in human form he humbled himself and became obedient unto death, even death on a cross.

Suggested song: The Greatest Thing (Page 46, #13)

SPIRITUAL DISPOSITION

Leader: Our Lord places before us His life of sacrifice in the Blessed Eucharist, wherein He Himself became a victim of propitiation for man's salvation. Thus, as Victims let us offer ourselves to the Sacred Heart. Let us be willing to offer sacrifices in union with Our Lord. O how hard it is to live without the love of God! Can anyone love the crucified Lord, without loving the cross and without being ready to die for it? To make this sacrifice more pleasing to the Sacred Heart, let us unite ourselves to the most Pure and Immaculate Heart of Mary and with the Choir of Virtues.

MOTIVATION

Leader: As **Victims**, let us reflect on the significance of the cross on which Jesus Christ was crucified. Let us ponder on what Christ seems to be saying: "I am looking for a victim soul who will console My wounded heart." The very love itself of Jesus Christ is the greatest motivation for victimhood. The manifestation of the secrets of the Sacred

Heart was the last effort of our Savior to invite us to respond to His great love.

ADORATION BEFORE THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

All: My God, / I ardently desire to sacrifice my whole being, / in union with the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, / so as to appease Your just wrath against us, poor sinners. I adore You, O Most Holy Trinity, / in union with the Holy Angelic Choir of Virtues. O God of Justice, / I unite myself to the Sacred Heart of Jesus Christ / who died as Victim of love for our salvation.

I offer You, Eternal Father, / in union with the Divine Heart, / myself--soul, body, all that I am, / both of the present and of the future. Have pity on me and on all poor sinners. / O Heart of Jesus, / I implore the grace to love You more and more . Mary, Mother of my Lord and my own Mother too, / make me love His Heart Divine.

O Sacred Heart who continues to offer Yourself upon our altars as a Victim for our salvation, / what more do You desire, / what more do You demand, / what do You ask / to unite ourselves with You as co-victims of Your sacrifice?

I am ready, O Lord. / Take possession of me, / that I may be a victim, / consecrated and consumed in the flames of Your love, / for the greater glory of Your Eternal Father and the salvation of sinners. Eternal Father, Who has chosen me to this office, / graciously accept me, / Your humble servant, / for the sake of Your only begotten Son, / Who died for love of me. Amen.

PRACTICE

Leader: Our duty as **Victims** consists in the control of the will, mortification of the heart and the discipline of the senses. Without the spirit of mortification, we can do little. Let us continuously check our emotional outburst when hurt or offended and resolve to offer these hurts for the conversion of all.



4. Fourth Office: DISCIPLE

We unite our prayers with the Immaculate Heart of Mary & the Choir of Cherubim

Leader: Matthew 28:18-20:

And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

Suggested song: Lord You Have Come to the Seashore (Page 45, #8)

SPIRITUAL DISPOSITION

Leader: As Disciples, let us go to the Heart of Jesus Christ to learn the science of the saints. It is in this school that true love is taught. It is in this school that true wisdom, the mother of fair love is imparted. It is the wisdom of Heaven that entirely surpasses all earthly wisdom. We must listen attentively to the voice of our Master, Who said: "Learn from me, for I am meek and humble of Heart." To obtain this wisdom, let us invoke the aid of the Most Pure heart of Mary and the Angelic Choir of the Cherubim.

MOTIVATION

Leader: As Disciples. let us reflect on the words of Christ: "Learn from Me, for I am meek and humble of heart." From our hearts, let us call out to Jesus and say: "Speak Lord, for Your servant is listening. Teach me to do Your will." Jesus Christ came to earth to teach us abject humility and meekness. He is our model and master in humility and ardent charity.

ADORATION BEFORE THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

All: Grant, O Lord / that everyone, especially priests and religious, / the teacher of the faithful, / may profit by the shining example of Your Divine Heart, / and never wander away from the path that leads to Heaven.

O Loving Jesus, / the only school that offers a course in Holy Love, / I wish to hide myself in You, / that You may remove in me all the vain wisdom of the world, / and inflame my heart with love for You.

O God, / who enlightens every man who comes into this world; / and who directs every will, / diffuse over us / the ecclesiastical light of Your uncreated Wisdom / and make them receive with docility / the sublime truths of Your Gospel. O the number of lessons of perfection, / coming to us from Your Divine Heart! / Grant that we may produce abundant fruits of Christian virtues. And You, O Cherubim, / take us into Your company, / that we may have some share, / in the splendor which comes from the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

O how quick in learning is the discipline taught by You, / O Lord Jesus. Instruct us, O Lord, to be Your disciples. Please open the doors of our hearts / and make them docile to Your Divine Words. / Through Your grace and power, / help us be Your instrument of bringing those who resist the truth back to You.. Amen.

PRACTICE

Leader: As **Disciples**, we must strive to be always recollected and silent, so that we can listen well to the voice and teachings of our Divine Master. Let us respond fully to the inspiration of grace coming from the Sacred Heart of Jesus.



5. Fifth Office: FAITHFUL SERVANT

We unite our prayers with the Immaculate Heart of Mary & the Choir of Archangels

Leader: Mark 10:43-45

"Whoever wishes to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wishes to be first among you must be slave of all. For the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life a ransom for many."

Suggested song: **Servant Song** (Page 45, #11)

SPIRITUAL DISPOSITION

Leader: According to St. Margaret Mary, our duty as **Faithful Servants** is to take to heart the obedience which Jesus unceasingly shows to His priests. We must, like our Lord, practice obedience in all things. We must learn to give up our self-will, our passions and inclinations, even our likes and dislikes. To obtain this spirit of obedience, the **Faithful Servant** should invoke the aid of the Most Pure Heart of Mary and the Choir of Archangels.

MOTIVATION

As **Faithful Servants** let us reflect on how Jesus humbled Himself and became a servant, saying: "I came not to be ministered unto, but to minister. If I, then, the Lord and Master, have washed Your feet, You must wash each other's feet. I have given You an example so that You may copy what I have done to You."

Our first and principal motive must be to render service to our Lord Who has given us an example on how to serve willingly, joyfully, and lovingly.

ADORATION BEFORE THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

All: O Sacred Heart of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, / what glory is mine in bearing the yoke of Your tender and generous love / which keeps me bound voluntarily to You! May the most high, just and adorable Will of God/ be done, praised and exalted above all forever!

Accept, / O Jesus Christ, / the offering which I, / Your most unworthy servant, / offer You now. May You be visited more frequently and with greater reverence in this Adorable Sacrament. / In return, may You bring forth in all hearts / the fruits of grace and salvation, / of which You are the inexhaustible Source.

O Heart of Jesus, / I implore You to grant me the grace to love You more and more. / Mary, Mother of my Lord and my own Mother too, / make me love His Heart Divine.

O, Almighty Love of my God! / You have broken the chains which held me captive and kept me far from You. Please help me to be able to draw more souls to You / -- all those who, like me, have gone astray, / and make them taste / at the foot of Your altar, / the same delights of Your service which I now experience, / a service which makes all its subjects happy. / O mystery of the subjection of Jesus in the Sacrament of Your love, / I give myself up to honor You, / and to strive to draw all hearts to You, O Jesus. Amen.

PRACTICE

Leader: It is our duty as Faithful Servants to obey promptly the divine aspirations. Let us imitate the obedience of the Sacred Heart, remembering that the most brilliant deeds done without obedience are not acceptable to God. Let us ever have the readiness and zeal to serve the Lord. (



6. Sixth Office: SUPPLICANT

We unite our prayers with the Immaculate Heart of Mary & the Choir of Angels

Leader: Philippians 4:4-8

Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, Rejoice. Let your gentleness be known to everyone. The Lord is near. Do not worry about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Finally, beloved, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is pleasing, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence and if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things.

Suggested song: Sweet Heart of Jesus (Page 46, #12)

SPIRITUAL DISPOSITION

Leader: St. Margaret Mary would often say: "The adorable Sacrament is the throne of Grace and Mercy."

One of the aims why Christ remains present with us in this mystery is to move sinners to come and implore His mercy. Acknowledging that we owe life to God's mercy, let us unite our petitions with that of the Sacred Heart, so that the many souls who might then be dead to God may begin to live the life of grace once more. To make this supplication more efficacious, let us unite our prayers with that of the Most Pure Heart of Mary and the Choir of Angels.

MOTIVITION

As **Supplicants**, let us reflect on the crown of thorns with which the Heart of Jesus is crowned. Through this, we will

come to know that it was caused by God's great love for man. We should be motivated by the promise of the Sacred Heart: "I promise to bestow abundant blessings on all the undertakings of those who honor My Heart."

ADORATION BEFORE THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

All: O Eternal Father, / animated by a lively faith / and full of confidence in the merits of the most Sacred Heart of Jesus, Your Son, / I offer them to You to obtain the fullness of Your grace / both for myself and for those who are in danger, / in either body or soul. Grant, O most merciful God, / Your grace to all the poor agonizing sinners / for the sake of the Sacred Heart of Jesus / and deliver the souls in Purgatory from their pains.

O Eternal Father, / for the sake of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, Your Son, / the sole subject of Your complacency, / grant me this particular grace.

O admirable Choir of Angels / and You in particular, my dear Guardian Angel, / accompany me on this visit to my Lord in the Eucharist / and together with the Sacred Heart of Jesus, / help me offer to the Eternal Father, / all the actions and sufferings of this day / for His greater glory / and for the release of the holy souls In Purgatory.

Hearken, O Divine Heart, / to the voices of those who are in need, / and be their comfort in tribulation; / for it has always been Your delight, O Most Merciful Heart, / to grant pardon and mercy to all. Amen.

PRACTICE

Leader: Our principal practice as **Supplicants** consists in performing acts of charity toward our neighbors. We must endeavor to imitate the spirit of prayer of the Sacred Heart, bearing in mind that without prayer, it is impossible to remain in the state of grace, let alone advance in virtue.



7. Seventh Office: PROMOTER

We unite our prayers with the Immaculate Heart of Mary & the Choir of Thrones

Leader: Matthew 5:14-16

"You are the light of the world. A city built on a hill cannot be hid. No one after lighting a lamp puts it under the bushel basket, but on the lampstand, and it gives light to all in the house. 16 In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven."

Suggested song: Here I am Lord (Page 44, #5)

SPIRITUAL. DISPOSITION

Leader: Our duty as **Promoter**s of the Sacred Heart is to make Him known to all mankind. We ask the Father and the Holy Spirit to move our hearts to love the Divine Heart of Jesus. We ask the Blessed Virgin to use her all-powerful intercession, that all who fly to it for aid, may find their consolation and strength therein. The fulfillment of this task often requires the aid of the most Pure heart of Mary and the Choir of Thrones.

MOTIVATION

Leader: As **Promoters**, we ought to be motivated by the thought that it is the most ardent desire of the Sacred Heart of Jesus that this devotion be spread as widely as possible.

ADORATION BEFORE THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

All: Grant us, / O Eternal Father/, the necessary light, so that all of us may come to the knowledge of the Sacred Heart of Your Son, Jesus. O Holy Spirit, / inflame our hearts with with the love of the Sacred Heart. And You also, / O Most Holy Virgin, / lend Your most powerful intercession, / so that all those who have recourse / to the infinite mercy of Your heart / may experience its power.

I adore You, O Jesus, in the Blessed Sacrament; / I adore Your Heart inflamed with love for me. You are the sweet recess of my repose, / the dear object of my love. My Jesus, I desire that at this moment, / You would come into my soul and consume it with Your love. To You I unite myself, / O august Choir of Thrones / in honoring the Divine Heart of Jesus. Amen.

PRACTICE

Leader: As Promoters we must have the zeal to spread the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus by our own example, molding our own hearts in imitation of the humble Heart of Jesus by the sweetness and gentleness of our manner. Giving an example is always so much more moving than preaching. May everything we do, think of and say, even our silence, speak of our love for the Sacred Heart of our Lord!



8. Eight Office: ZEALOUS FRIEND

We unite our prayers with the Immaculate Heart of Mary & the Choir of Principalities

Leader: John 14:2-3

In my Father's house there are many dwelling places. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, so that where I am, there you may be also.

Suggested song: Come into my heart (Page 44, #2)

SPIRITUAL DISPOSITION

Leader: As Zealous Friends of the Sacred Heart, let us consider ourselves charged with the furtherance of the interest of the Sacred Heart of Jesus among our brothers and sisters. We regret that we cannot make known to the whole world the rich treasures of grace stored up in His Heart; treasures which our Lord is only too ready to pour out upon His faithful friends. Let us therefore make use of all the means at our command to instill this most sweet devotion into the minds of others, since it is a short way to perfection and a sure means of salvation. In fulfilling our duty, we ought to act in union with and implore the aid of the Most Pure Heart of Mary and the Choir of Principalities.

MOTIVATION

Leader: As Zealous Friends of the Sacred Heart, let us consider the sweet look our Lord casts on the just saying: "Behold My Heart which has loved men so much and is so little loved in return by them," and resolve to use every means of making Him loved. Our motivating spirit must be the same zeal which consumed the Sacred Heart of Jesus, manifested through our deeds, our words, and our sentiments.

ADORATION BEFORE THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

All: O Sacred Heart of Jesus, / glorify Yourself through Your own power, / making all with Your aid, / attain the perfection of Christian virtue. And You, O Principalities of the Heavenly Court, / present Yourselves / with all the Heavenly Choirs before the Divine Majesty / and obtain by Your intercession, that the Sacred Heart may be known / in every part of the world / and that He may draw to His love / all the idolaters and infidels that do not know Him / and also those Christians who deny Him His rightful adoration.

O adorable Heart, / how great is my desire to atone in a worthy manner /, first for by myself for not having given You all the honor that You deserve as as the most Sacred Heart of Jesus, and for my brothers and sisters who do not know and adore You.

I adore You, / O Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. I adore Your Heart inflamed with love for us. O Jesus, come at this moment into our hearts / and consume them with Your love. O Heart of Jesus who loves us so much, / how lovable You are! When shall we see You loved by all?

May the most holy, / most adorable Sacred Heart of Jesus be glorified and praised / throughout the world / now and forever! Amen.

PRACTICE

Leader: As **Zealous Friends** of the Sacred Heart, let us strive with holy zeal and discretion to put a stop to every outrage against our Lord for whom we must win love by word and example. Let us encourage and exhort all those whom we can, particularly our friends and acquaintances, to give some token of love to the Sacred Heart, above all, by frequent Confession, Holy Communion and Holy Hours of Adoration. 9. Ninth Office: REPARATORS

We unite our prayers with the Immaculate Heart of Mary & the Choir of Powers

Leader: Psalm 69:20

"Insult has broken my heart past cure. I hoped for sympathy, but in vain, for consolers.—not one to be found."

Suggested song: Heart of Jesus (Page 44, #4)

SPIRITUAL DISPOSITION

Leader: Our chief duty as Reparators, according to St. Margaret Mary, consists in humbly craving for God's pardon for all the Insults to which the Sacred Heart of Jesus is continually being outraged in the Blessed Sacrament. Our faithful performance of this duty will ensure the well grounded hope that pardon will be extended to our own sins. Let us bear in mind what our Lord once said to His faithful servant: "Will no one take pity on My sorrow and come to aid Me, outraged, as I am now by sinners?"

For our acts of reparation to be acceptable to the Divine Heart, let us unite ourselves with the Most Pure Heart of Mary and the Choir of Powers..

MOTIVATION

Leader: As Reparators, let us reflect on Jesus showing His Heart and giving us a look of affection. With His right hand He points to His own Heart and with His left asks for ours, saying: "My child, entrust to Me Your Heart." Let us be motivated by the same object our Lord had in instituting this dear devotion — to enkindle in all hearts greater love for God.

All: I ask pardon O my God /, for the offenses You continuously receive in the Most Blessed Eucharist. O august Choir of Heavenly Powers, / come to my aid in atoning from the Sacred Heart of Jesus: / all the Masses half-heartedly celebrated, / Communions made by souls in a state of tepidity, / especially by souls who are consecrated to You, / and chiefly by myself and my fellow worshippers. Finally, help us to atone for all we may have done that is displeasing to You.

O most clement Heart of Jesus, / Divine Propitiator, / through whom the Eternal Father has promised that He would hear our prayers, / saying to Margaret Mary: Pray to Me through My Sacred Heart, / through this Heart will I hearken to Your prayers / and You will obtain whatever You desire.

Together with You and in You, / I offer to Your Eternal Father this poor heart of mine, / contrite and sorrowful / because of the sins I have committed, / especially in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament, / and more so because of those which I myself have had the misfortune to commit.

Would I were able, / O Divine Redeemer / to blot out with my tears /and wash away with my blood / all the ingratitude shown by me in return for the excess of Your love!

To the weak sorrow I feel for my sins, / I add the poignant grief You felt during the prayer and agony of sweat / In the Garden of Gethsemane, / at the sight of my sins and those of all men / and present them to Your Eternal Father/ together with Your own Sacred Heart. Supply and make up with Your love, / my ingratitude, indifference and >

forgetfulness / of such an incomparable benefit / and grant me henceforth reverence in Your presence, / that thus I may repair the past / and by my example / draw many souls to Your love / to which I devote and consecrate myself from this moment, / choosing Your most Sacred Heart / as my lasting abode. For You are my King, / my Spouse, / my Friend, / my Guide, / my Support, / my Hope, / my joy in time and eternity.

I shut myself up in Your wounds, / O Sacred Heart of Jesus, / never more to be separated from You. I offer, / O my God, / to Your Divine Majesty / this Most Sacred Heart / in satisfaction for so many outrages / which You continuously receive from sinners.

O most loving Heart of Jesus, / how many outrages do You receive in the adorable Eucharist! Here, / You give us the most beautiful proof of Your love, / but the world shows the excess of its ingratitude. / If I could only blot out with my blood those many fearful iniquities! / O my Jesus, / I will make use of every means of making reparation for so many offenses. I will consecrate to You all the days of my life / for love of Your most Sacred Heart / and give You the last breath of my life. Amen.

PRACTICE

Leader: As **Reparators**, we must observe all the duties of our state of life, overcoming for this purpose every human obstacle. In sincere humility of spirit and in humble acknowledgement of our sins and with great confidence in the merits of Jesus Christ, we make this reparation to His Sacred Heart for all the injuries He receives.


The Chaplet of Divine Mercy





First Friday Devotion & the 12 Sacred Heart Promises

St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690) reported visions of Jesus Christ directing her to promote devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on nine consecutive First Fridays in reparation for sins and in order to show love to Jesus. In return for this act of devotion, which usually includes Mass, Communion, confession and even an hour of Eucharistic Adoration on the eve of the first Friday of the month, our blessed Savior promised St. Margaret Mary the following blessings

Twelve Promises of the Sacred Heart to St. Margaret Mary:

- 1) I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.
- 2) I will give peace in their families.
- 3) I will console them in all their troubles.
- 4) I will be their refuge in life and especially in death.
- 5) I will abundantly bless all their undertakings.
- 6) Sinners shall find in my Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
- 7) Tepid souls shall become fervent.
- 8) Fervent souls shall rise speedily to great perfection.
- **9)** I will bless those places wherein the image of my Sacred Heart shall be exposed and venerated.
- **10)** I will give to priests the power to touch the most hardened hearts.
- **11)** Persons who propagate this devotion shall have their names eternally written in my Heart.
- 12) In the excess of the mercy of my heart, I promise you that my all powerful love will grant to all those who will receive Communion on the First Fridays, for nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance: they will not die in my displeasure, nor without receiving the sacraments; and my Heart will be their secure refuge in that last hour.

Requirements to fulfill promises of the Sacred Heart

- Receive Holy Communion on each First Friday for 9 consecutive months.
- They must be made in honor of and in reparation to the Sacred Heart.
