THE "O" ANTIPHONS

This week is the week of the "O" antiphons starting Dec. 17. These are recited during evening prayer in the Liturgy of the Hours before the Magnificat is said as we approach the solemnity of Christmas. They are centuries old & each one invokes a title of the Messiah.

Dec. 17: *O Sapientia* O Wisdom of Him Who created & governs all creation. Wisdom comes to show us the way home. Isaiah refers to it in Is. 11:2-3 & 28:29 which refer to the greatness of His wisdom.

Dec. 18: *O Adonai* O Sacred Lord Who manifested Himself to Moses & gave Him the Law & comes to set us free. Is. 11:4-5 speaks of His justice & faithfulness & the majesty of the Lord our King Who will save us. (Is:33:22)

Dec. 19: *O Radix Jesse* O Flower of Jesse's Stem. Jesse was the father of King David & from his line will bloom a new shoot destined to save the world. The Gentiles will seek Him out for His dwelling will be glorious. (Is 11:10)

Dec. 20: *O Clavis David* O Key of David open the doors of darkness & set the captives free. What He opens no one will shut & what He shuts no one will open. (Is 22:22)


Dec. 21: *O Oriens* O Radiant Dawn, the splendor of eternal light. The people who walked in darkness & gloom have seen a great light. (Is 9:1)

Dec. 22: *O Rex Gentium* O King of all the Nations Who will judge between the nations & impose terms on many people. (Is 2:4)

Dec. 23: *O Emmanuel* O Emmanuel God is With Us. The Lord will give you a sign: the Virgin shall bear a Son & His Name will be Emmanuel. (Is 7:14)

So many prophecies from Isaiah were fulfilled & in our day we see many more Old Testament & New Testament prophecies being fulfilled at a very rapid rate. We seem to be racing to some final confrontation which JPII warned us about back in 1976...the last & greatest confrontation between good & evil, the Gospel & the anti-Gospel. This is a battle way beyond our pay grade for it is being waged in the heavenlies & on the earth for the souls of men...our souls. We need to shield ourselves from the onslaught. He, the enemy, is trying to outflank us at every turn denying us access to the arms we need...the sanctifying grace in the sacraments & endless attacks on the ministers of those much needed sacraments. He seeks to squelch the truth on the internet labeling it as hate speech & castigating those who espouse it. It is time to close ranks. Tune out the propaganda being spewed out by the "Tokyo Roses" of the major media outlets of our day meant to demoralize & divide us. As we recall that day of infamy this month with the bombing of Pearl Harbor & the start of a second WW II front, let us remember those who made the ultimate sacrifice & are laid to rest in cemeteries across Europe, Asia & the Pacific & make sure that sacrifice was not made in vain by letting in the forces of totalitarianism they fought against come in through the front door. We were born for such a time as this & though many of us have taken up the arms of Our Lady, this is no time to quit or back off. Let us redouble our rosaries, our prayers & sacrifices, our fasting & getting to the sacraments as best we can to rescue souls. Let our motto be the motto of our Marines: No soul left behind! The enemy has media power..we have the power to turn it off. We have knee power...prayer power & allies no political party can match. We await the One Who came to free us from all sin & came to set us free from captivity in this enemy territory. We await the coming of the Supreme Commander.
