### **FROM FISH TO MEN**

Who would have thought that a recalcitrant, self righteous, fearful prophet would be used by God to bring in a harvest of repentant souls in Nineveh, the traditional enemy of Israel? So angry & fearful was Jonah, he ran away & tried to hide from God of all people & ended up in the belly of a whale. After the rigors of shipwreck & re-gurgitation, Jonah was given the commission a second time to prepare a harvest of souls in Nineveh by calling for repentance. And then was even angry when they repented...so disgusted with the success of this mission that he wanted to die! Such petulant selfishness...but God used him anyway for He is always more concerned for souls than politics & petulance.



### **AND ALONG COMES JESUS....**

...to fishers of fish in what must have been the most compelling look in the world & starts the transformation of fishers of fish into fishers of men. Instead of their daily pursuing a school of fish, they became enrolled in a school of discipleship that took them to the ends of the known world at the time. 
