## **MORE MYSTERY & THE GREATEST MIRACLE.**

As we do this so often, it is easy to slip into distraction or risk taking it for granted or just go through the motions to fulfill an obligation & it ends up as some kind of perfunctory performance. That is why serious preparation for Sunday Mass must take place during the week preceding it. Delving into the readings for that Sunday & better yet, sharing them with other believers is a critical way of immersing ourselves in the Mystery of Who it is we will be receiving & thus disposing ourselves to receive Him worthily, fully aware that the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity is taking up residence in the hearts of His creatures, us. Here at St. A's, you can tune into exactly that every Tuesday evening at 8PM either in person or on Zoom.

*This worship is directed towards God the Father, through Jesus Christ in the Holy Spirit. This worship, given therefore to the Trinity of the Father & of the Son & of the Holy Spirit, above all accompanies & permeates the celebration of the Eucharistic liturgy. And this worship must be prominent in all our encounters with the Blessed Sacrament, both when we visit our churches & when the sacred species is taken to the sick. Adoration of Christ in this sacrament of love must also find expression in various forms of Eucharistic devotion: personal prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, hours of Adoration, periods of exposition, Eucharistic processions & congresses. Particular mention should be made of the Solemnity of Corpus Christi as an act of public worship rendered to Christ in the Eucharist. (Pope John Paul II, The Mystery & Worship of the Eucharist)*



## **EUCARISTIC WORSHIP CONSTITUTES THE SOUL OF ALL CHRISTIAN LIFE.**

*When we realize WHO it is that we receive in Eucharistic Communion, there springs up in us almost spontaneously a sense of unworthiness, together with sorrow for our sins & an interior need for purification. But we must always take care that this great meeting with Christ in the Eucharist DOES NOT BECOME A MERE HABIT.*

*This worship comes from the heart, as a most precious homage inspired by the faith, hope & charity which were infused in us at Baptism. (Pope John Paul II)*


Speaking of Baptism, let us be consciously faithful to the vows we renew every Easter Vigil keeping in mind, *That when we quench the grace of Baptism, then it is that we need severe trials to restore us. This is the case of the multitude whose best estate is that of chastisement, repentance, supplication & absolution again & again.*

*Then there are those who are on a calm & unswerving course, i.e. Mary & all real contemplatives. (John Henry Newman)*

And even they are now under scrutiny & attack; yet it is these very souls of perpetual contemplative adoration who keep the world intact.

*The Church has a special duty to safeguard & strengthen the sacredness of the Eucharist, yet perversion & worldly entertainment is allowed to go on in its Presence to say nothing of the threats to its theft & desecration that are going on today. There is no greater thing to be willing to die for than protection of the Holy Eucharist for it is God Himself.*

*The Roman Church has special obligations towards Latin & she must manifest them whenever the occasion presents itself. (Pope John Paul II) And wasn't that so beautifully done on Pentecost? Latin is the universal language of the Church that cannot be changed & the Gregorian chant is the universal music of the Church that touched so many hearts on Pentecost.
