#### **THE MYSTERY OF THE HOLY TRINITY**

**ITY** is the central mystery of Christian faith & life. It is the mystery of God in Himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental & essential teaching in the “hierarchy of the truths of the faith.” The whole history of salvation is identical with the history of the way & the means by which the One True God, Father, Son & Holy Spirit, reveals Himself to men “& reconciles & unites with Himself those who turn away from sin.” (#234, Catechism of the Catholic Church)

#### **THE TRINITY IS A MYSTERY OF FAITH**

, one of the mysteries that are hidden in God, which can never be known unless they are revealed by God. To be sure God has left traces of His Trinitarian being in His work of creation & in His revelation throughout the Old Testament. But His inmost Being as Holy Trinity is a mystery that is inaccessible to reason alone or even to Israel’s faith before the Incarnation of God’s Son & the sending of the Holy Spirit. (#237, Catechism of the Catholic Church)

**BY CALLING GOD “FATHER”** indicates 2 main things: that God is the first origin of everything & transcendent authority; that He is at the same time goodness & loving care. The language of faith draws on the human experience of parents, who are in a way the first representatives of God for man. But human parents are fallible & can disfigure the face of fatherhood & motherhood. God transcends the human distinction between the sexes.

#### **HE IS NEITHER MAN NOR WOMAN. HE IS GOD.**

He also transcends human fatherhood & motherhood, although He is their origin & standard. No one is Father as God is Father. (#239 Catechism of the Catholic Church)

#### **THE TRINITY IS ONE.**

We do not confess three Gods, but one God in three persons, the “consubstantial Trinity”. The divine persons do not share the one divinity among themselves but each of them is God whole & entire: the Father is that which the Son is, the Father & the Son that which the Holy Spirit is, i.e., by nature one God. Each of the persons is that supreme reality, the divine substance, essence of nature. (#253 Catechism of the Catholic Church)

#### **IN GOD’S PLAN....**

...every child that comes into the world in the way God intended is a trinity in itself...mother, father, child, a reflection of the divine Family of God...the sacred Trinity.

May we look at our families & ourselves & be in awe of God’s plan of creation & salvation.

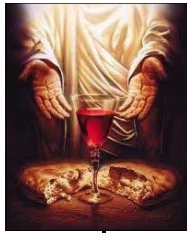


The ultimate purpose of each life He brings into the world is to pass through the trial of this life through the grace of Jesus to enable us to go back to our true home...the heart of the Trinity.
