I AM COMING AMONG YOU IN 2 WAYS: THE CROSS & THE EUCHARIST.

The cross is My way of coming down among My children, since it is through it that I caused My Son to redeem you. And for you, the Cross is the way to ascend to My Son & from My Son to Me. TODAY IS THE FEAST OF GOD THE FATHER...

... the first Sunday of August, requested by the Father Himself in His approved revelations to Sr. Eugenia Ravasio who died in 1990, thus these revelations are most pertinent to our times. Every thing at Mass is offered to the Father, the Creator of us all. This homage is reflected in the very opening prayer of today's Mass: *Almighty & ever-living God, Whom taught by the Holy Spirit, we dare to call our Father, bring, we pray, to perfection in our hearts the spirit of adoption as your sons & daughters.*

Would that the awesome wonder of that pierce our hearts. The Creator of time & space Who then flung into it galaxies that are still being born into a universe that is still expanding, this is the Father Who created & maintains it at His whim & invites us all to be a part of it. All creation was an act of redemption creating an arena of salvation His Son entered to redeem us from eternal death which all humankind merited as a result of the sin of our first parents. The wages of sin is death & such is the love of the Father that He provided a way for all those He lovingly created in His image to be able to return to Him. His Son paid the debt of death by taking on a human nature & dying & destroying the power of death by rising from it. He ransomed our souls & saved us from the eternal perdition of hell if we but believe in Him & what He did for us & seek Him while He may still be found as a merciful God before He returns as the just Judge. Prepare your souls now. Cleanse them with repentance & reparation & *do not be afraid any longer little flock, for the Father is pleased to give you the Kingdom. (Luke 12:32..in today's Gospel)*

This marvelous world, so loved by the Father that He sent His only Son for its salvation is the theater of a never ending battle being waged for our dignity & identity as free, spiritual beings. This struggle parallels the apocalyptic combat described in Rev. 12. Death battles against life, a culture of death seeks to impose itself on our desire to live & to live to the full. There are those who reject the light of life, preferring the fruitless works of darkness. (Eph 5:11) Their harvest is injustice, discrimination, exploitation, deceit, violence. In every age, a measure of their apparent success is the death of the innocents. In our own century, as at no other time in history, the culture of death has assumed a social & institutional form of legality to justify the most horrible crimes against humanity: genocide, "final solutions", ethnic cleansing & the massive taking of lives of human beings even before they are born, or before they reach the natural point of death. (Pope John Paul II, Homily in Colorado, Aug. 15, 1993)
