MY HOUR HAS COME! I must be known, loved & honored by men so that, having created them, I can be their Father, then their Savior & finally the object of their eternal delights.



I am coming to bring hope to men & nations. How many have long since lost it! The hope will make them live in peace & security working for their salvation.


I am coming to make Myself known just as I am, so
