Introduction(

The First Saturday Devotion began as a promise made by Our Lady to Lucia on July 13th, 1917, that there would be a future manifestation concerning the practice of the Five First Saturdays. This was fulfilled 8 years later on December 10th, 1925, when Lucia was a postulant sister in the Dorothean Convent in Tuy, Spain.



On this occasion Our Lady appeared together with the Child Jesus, Who spoke first to Lucia:

"Have compassion on the Heart of Your Most Holy Mother, covered with thorns which ungrateful men place therein at every moment, while there is no one who does an act of reparation to withdraw them for her."

"Behold, my daughter, my Heart encircled with thorns, with which ungrateful men pierce It at every moment by their blasphemies and ingratitude. Give me consolation, You, at least; and make known on my behalf that I promise to assist at the hour of death, with the graces necessary for salvation, all who on the First Saturday of five consecutive months :

- (1) shall confess
- (2) receive Holy Communion,
- (4) recite five decades of the Rosary,
- (5) and keep me company for fifteen minutes meditating the mysteries of the Rosary, with the purpose of making reparation to my Immaculate Heart.

Note again the **promise of our Blessed Mother** for those who fulfill the requirements with the intention for reparation: **she promises to be with us at the hour of death with "necessary graces for salvation."**

Why 5 First Saturdays?

Jesus explained this to Sr. Lucia on May 29-30, 1930, saying:

"Daughter, the motive is simple: There are five kinds of offenses and blasphemies spoken against the Immaculate Heart of Mary. "

First: blasphemies against the Immaculate Conception

Second: against her Virginity

Third: against the Divine Maternity, refusing, at the same time, to receive her as he Mother of mankind

Fourth: those who seek publicly to implant, in the hearts of children, indifference, disrespect, and even hate for this Immaculate Mother.

Fifth: those who revile her directly in her sacred images.

You revealed the secrets of your own sad heart at Fatima / and begged for penance, prayer, / and conversion of the world to God. What more can I do / than unite my heart to yours in this great yearning? What can I add / but the fervent prayer / that all the world may listen to your pleading?

I give my heart to you, my heavenly Queen, / and in confidence I leave to you what is best for me / in answer to my prayer for love and reparation.

Immaculate Heart of the Mother of my God, / I implore through your powerful intercession, / the conversion of the hearts of men, / complete victory over sin, / and the return of the peace which you have promised. Amen

5. Leader: "Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring You good news of great joy which shall be to all the people." (Lk 2:10)

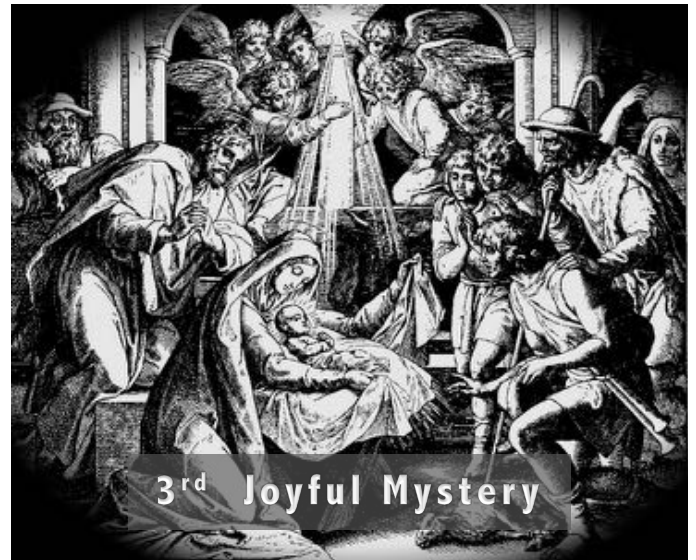
