

Muskego Norway School District Mentoring Program

I am looking for volunteers for the following program I am piloting through Lakepoint and Muskego School District. Here is a little more info about the programs. Please let me know what questions you have. Thank you so much for considering making an important difference in the life of a child. If you are interested, please let me know if you prefer elementary or middle school and your availability during the school day. Elementary is 9:00-3:45 and Middle School is 8:05-3:05. Before and after school may be available as well as long as it is okay with parents/guardians and they are able to provide that transportation.

- Country Meadows is the elementary school and Lake Denoon is the middle school.
- Mentors will be paired up with one student based on the time that works for you.
- The goal of the program is to provide a positive relationship to the child.
- Paperwork is just one slip of paper. We would need all volunteers to register with the district. I will get that to you.
- We would provide the child's parent with either your email address or phone number so that if they needed to get ahold of you, they could. Communication would be with the classroom teacher.
- You would provide me with your availability and the students' teacher will work around your availability. Country Meadows elementary has more flexibility in the way the schedule works. For instance, one week lunch time may work and the next time, it could be a total different time. Lake Denoon would be a more rigid schedule just because of the room changes and such.
- The time commitment would be every other week, but if you are able to do weekly, that would be even better!
- 30 min. time periods is what we are looking at.
- There is a lot of possibilities to what you can do with your student. Ideas include, but are not limited to: playing a game, having lunch, leaving a note/small treat in locker, playing at recess, reading a book, drawing, craft, legos, etc. If you have a passion for something, please feel free to share it with your student and/or visa versa asking what the student enjoys.
- Communication will be between you and the classroom teacher. I am here as well to provide direction and answer any questions.
- My hope is to find a common time or two for mentors to come to the school together and meet the students all at once together. This way I can show you how to enter the building, show you where classroom is, introduce you to teachers/principal, etc.
- I also hope to find 1-2 times this school year where we can do something all together (examples include like a pizza lunch party, craft of some sort).
