

- Support Medical and Social
Determinants of Health (SDH):**
- Connection to primary care providers
 - Connection to mental health and substance abuse providers
 - Connection to needed medications
 - Assistance with housing
 - Connection to social services (SNAP, HEAP, Disability, etc.)
 - Referral to community and social support services
 - Comprehensive care management; patient goal setting and follow-up
 - Health promotion and education
 - Patient advocacy
 - Comprehensive transitional care/follow-up
 - Gaps in care closure
 - Patient provider, family and community engagement
 - Response to RHIO alerts within 48 hours

What is Health Home?

- The Health Home Program is an innovative care coordination model for Medicaid recipients with chronic conditions who find it difficult to navigate the health system and find the appropriate health care providers and/or services.
- Health Home operate under a "whole-person" philosophy – coordination of primary care, behavioral health, and long-term services and supports to treat the whole person.

The goal of the Health Home program is to make sure its members receive the care and services they need to become and stay healthy.

- Health Home Serving Adults (HHSa)
 - Ages 18+
- Health Home Serving Children (HHSC)
 - Ages 0-21
- *Individuals between the ages of 18-21 have the right to choose which program better meets his or her needs.

Program Benefits

Greater patient engagement in personal health

ADMISSION CRITERIA

Active Medicaid (MCO)

Two or more chronic conditions

Or

One single qualifying conditions (SMI, HIV/AIDS, SED (CHH))

Health Navigators

- ✓ Conduct outreach and enrollments for the HH program
- ✓ Can conduct enrollments over the phone, next appointment, or patient's home

Care Managers

- ✓ Long-term comprehensive care management services
- ✓ Care coordination
- ✓ Connection to providers
- ✓ Connection to community resources
- ✓ Additional support services

Integration

- We current have Care Managers stationed at 966 Prospect Ave in the Bronx and 1776 Clay Avenue
- Our Health Navigators are currently integrating with sites such as La Casa de Salud, Casa Maria, Ramon Velez Recovery Center, Carlos Pagan, and 915 Westchester Center of Excellence.
- Our vision is to have a Care Manager and Health Navigator in every Acacia Site in order to provide true integrated quality services.
- All staff are field workers and travel between the 5 boroughs and lower Westchester County to service our members.
