<u>What is FYI?</u> Facilitating Youth Involvement, F.Y.I. is a combined recreation and skill development experience for Alliston and area youth between the ages of 13 and 21, who are in or entering high school and have a developmental disability. The program focuses on giving youth the opportunity to develop their social and life skills while connecting them to their own and surrounding community through fun filled activities.

Important Information

- Sign up for the following activities is to be completed online through Rec Desk. If you are new to the program and are interested in signing up for Summer programs please reach out to Heather Barzo. If you are already attending the FYI program but have not received Rec Desk information please reach out to Kailey Hawkins. All additional information for the day including cost and important notes for each day will be documents on Rec Desk under program description and notes. Please read for more detailed information.
- Rec Desk Sign Up: When signing up for programs there may be two costs. Please ensure you are selecting both the **daily rate** as well as the **activity fee.** If any fee types are missed you will be billed and required to pay the balance through Rec Desk.
- Cost of program is \$50.00 a day plus the activity fees outlined on Rec Desk.
- Families are required to register online through Rec Desk. Summer registration will close; **June 30th** for the month of **July** and **July 25th** for the month of **August.**
- Teens will be expected to bring pocket money.
- Transportation to and from the program is the responsibility of the family.
- All pick ups and drop offs are at CLASS, 181 Barrie Street, Bradford. Punctuality with arriving and departures are mandatory. Drop off is 9:00AM and pick up is 4:00PM
- Teens are required to bring their own lunch, snacks, and sufficient drinks to keep them hydrated throughout the day unless otherwise specified.
- Teens are required to wear appropriate footwear and clothing for the daily activities.
- Schedules may change the day of due to interest of the group or weather.
