Eligibility:

1. Applicants must be a **2022** graduating high school senior **OR** a current college student.
2. Applicants **must be a resident** of one of the following cities:
 - a. Grand Prairie
 - b. Irving
 - c. Mansfield
 - d. Midlothian
3. Applicants must be (or plan to be) enrolled full-time and study at an accredited two-year or four-year college or university for the entire upcoming academic year.
4. Applicants must have achieved a cumulative 2.7 GPA or higher.
5. Applicants must plan to pursue a major **OR** minor in Fine Arts, Performing or Visual Arts.
6. Previous winners of this scholarship are ineligible to apply.
