Amended to remove health care costs from timeloss calculation but left in equity piece that will cost the system \$37 million over a five year period. Only impact for construction would be the provisions requiring payment for break or leave time if accommodations not made that can adapt in a way that works during work time. <u>SSB 5351</u> (HB 1535)	Dental insurance practices Ensuring patient choice and access to care by prohibiting unfair and deceptive dental insurance practices. Bill was modified to make a couple small changes but then push the rest of the discussion to a study process that will include denturists.	Del to Gov	King	High	Support
