It establishes a framework for limiting the fees healthcare providers can charge individuals for accessing their own medical records. Specifically, it limits fees to \$50 for patients and their representatives, including legal representatives and guardians. This bill also requires the Department of Social and Health Services to adopt rules to ensure these fees are reasonable and based on actual costs, particularly considering the growing use of electronic records.
