## 1) COVID: Self / Public Care Guidelines

#### **Avoid contact / Social Distancing**

Always remain 2 meters (6 feet) away from others. Do not hug or shake hands. It is highly recommended to wear a mask or a handmade face covering when leaving your pit area. Be sure to use hygienic practices when coughing or sneezing and immediately wash your hands.

## Wash your hands OFTEN

Frequent hand washing is the best way to protect yourself and others from coronavirus, and when possible carry/use hand sanitizer.

Even if you wear a mask or handmade face covering, you should continue to employ protective hand hygiene and other measures.

#### WHEN should I wash my hands?

As often as possible, but especially:

- Before I touch my face (eyes, mouth, nose)
- · After I cough, sneeze or blow my nose
- Before and after I provide care to a close friend or family member
- When my hands are visibly dirty or after I touch a dirty object
- · Before and after I prepare meals
- Before and after I eat
- After using the toilet
- Before and after going to a public place
- Before putting on a mask or homemade face covering and after removing it







## 2) COVID Restrictions / Procedures

#### Waivers:

Every person (no exceptions) entering the property must sign waivers: racers, family, flaggers, medics, staff, etc.

## **Overnight Parking:**

- Overnight parking will only be available for those in self-contained camper trailers or RV's. \$20 for Camping.
- Tent camping is not allowed
- no groups larger than 5 will be permitted to stay in one camper
- Only those who arrived in a camper will be permitted to stay in that camper overnight
- All vehicles entering the property will be parked by parking staff.
- No water will be supplied. You must bring your own water in your own self contained water supply
- Bonfires are not permitted. No evening social gatherings.
- Gates close at 8:30 pm on Friday/ Saturday. **No exceptions**. If you arrive after 8:30pm you will not be able to enter the property and parking alongside the road is not permitted. Gates re-open at 6am Sunday morning.
- The gate will close again at 9am on Raceday.
- Unless your racer is on the track, stay in your designated pit area

#### **Definition of Crew:**

A crew member is someone that helps the rider, with the bike, body, and mind. Someone that contributes to the riders race day. Crew members can be; a Parent, a sibling, a spouse, a friend, etc.

#### **Spectators:**

NO SPECTATORS WILL BE ALLOWED. We must keep the minimum amount of people on the property. No unnecessary people are allowed to be part of the riders/racers crew. PLEASE do your best to bring just people/family/supporter that is needed. A limit of 6 total including racer will be permitted. This group must stay in their designated pits unless watching their Rider during the day.

#### Parking:

ALL VEHICLES must be distanced as directed by Parking Staff in pits. All camping trailers must NOT have awnings facing each other. This follows all social distancing protocols.

- Vehicles must be distanced as directed by Parking Staff
- If you bring a portable tent it MUST go behind trailer/race vehicle NOT to the side
- There are garbage bins on site. Please ensure your garbage goes in there or take it home.
- You will be parked by a Track or Jetwerx Staff. NO SAVING SPOTS





## **Riders Meeting:**

There will be no riders meeting but rather it will be announced over speakers and through a dedicated radio channel. That info will be released Saturday morning at the event through social media and over the speaker system. \*\*Sunday Morning for WMX / Premix

### Staging/Start Gate:

One mechanic per rider. All mechanics must wear a mask. If this is not followed, you will forfeit your racer's gate pick. No excuses. Staff for staging and operating the Gates will also wear a mask.

#### Awards:

Podiums will not take place, but will have separated interviews for TV. All payback will be at the following Round or mailed, in Cheque form, and will be based off riders Overall finish.

## Your designated Pit area:

You are responsible for your pit area and your crew. Any breaking of the above regulations will be disciplined through the riders results.

### Security:

More staff will be on-site patrolling the grounds, to ensure people are following social distancing measures outside of their pits. Treat these people with respect and if they ask you do break apart or move along, then please obey them.

## 3) How to Register to Race ALL REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ONLINE

- 1. Be sure to register for a Motorsport Racing Canada (MRC) License, you can do so at <a href="https://www.MRCRacing.com">www.MRCRacing.com</a>
- 2. After getting your license you will go to <u>rockstartriplecrown.com</u> and follow the link to Race registration. \*\*You CANNOT race without a MRC membership
- 3. There will only be 40 riders allowed in each class (450 Pro, 250 Pro, PreMix, WMX)
- 4. Registration will Close Wednesday prior to the event. NO LATE REGISTRATIONS
- 5. Waivers will be Online and attached to your registration. All Riders and Crew must sign individual waivers.
- 6. After completing registration, you MUST do all gate fees, for the Rider and all crew members (Max 5 crew allowed)
- 7. Riders with Credentials will have a Code to enter, to cover the cost of their gate fee.





8. Be sure to have all members waivers signed prior to leaving for the event, this is the responsibility of the rider.

## 4) Eligibility / Bike Requirement

**450** - Open to all MRC Pro's, AMA Pro or A ranked riders only. Out of Canada participants must submit proof of Pro ranked status when applying for a Pro license.

- Bike must be a 450 four stroke or 250 two stroke
- Bike must have white backgrounds and black numbers
- Bust must have a transponder (rentals at track)
- Rider must have corresponding number on the back of jersey or chest protector

## 250 - Open to all riders with the exception of:

- Two-time 250 or former 450 Canadian champions within 5 years of their last title
- AMA Pro riders Finishing top 10 Overall in the Outdoor Nationals for past 3 years (250 & 450 class)
- AMA Pro riders Finishing top 10 Overall in Supercross series for past 3 years (450 class)
- AMA Pro/ FIM GP's riders claiming championships in the past 5 years
- FIM GP's riders (MXG/MX2) finishing the season top 10
- Bike must be a 250 four stroke
- \*\* 250 Two Strokes for Canadian Privateers ONLY
- Bike must have black backgrounds and white numbers
- Bike must have a transponder (rentals at track)
- Rider must have corresponding number on the back of jersey or chest protector

**WMX** - Open to women 14 years of age and older, Competent to be racing on a National caliber track.

- Bike must be a 250 four stroke or 125 250 two stroke
- Bike must have Blue backgrounds and white numbers
- Bike must have a transponder (rentals at track)
- Rider must have corresponding number on the back of jersey or chest protector

**FXR PreMix** - Open to riders 12 years of age or older, Competent to be racing a National caliber track.

- Bike must be on a 125 150cc two stroke (No minis)
- Bike must have white backgrounds and black numbers
- Bike must have a transponder (rentals at track)
- Bike must have Rockstar Triple Crown / MRC front and side number plate stickers
- Rider must have corresponding number on the back of jersey or chest protector





All participants must hold a full 2020 MRC License in order to compete in their respective class. Licenses can be purchased online.

All riders will be scanned in while coming in to the Park, it is the Riders responsibility to have all proper equipment. If you are unsure of something, the Officials will be at the Administration trailer, and will be ready to help (Mask must be worn while coming to the Admin trailer)

## 6) Rider Weekend Check In

Riders will all register ONLINE, for the race as well as gate entry. When arriving to the track, the rider will be checked in at the Gate. A Mandatory heat check for all riders will take place while getting checked in at the Gate.

**THERE WILL BE NO BIKE TECH -** Riders and Mechanics will be responsible to have proper bike set up / requirements (as seen in section 4)

## 7) Practice / Qualifying Day

For each class, it will be limited to 40 riders per class, making qualifying only necessary for First Moto gate pick.

The first practice will be a FREE practice, and un-timed. All 40 riders will ride in the same FREE Practice. Qualifying seeds (A/B) will be decided by 2019 Points for the First Round and Factory Riders, after Round 1 it will be decided by the current points standing.

Sunday FREE Practice, is optional and will be un-timed.

## 8) Staging Procedure

For all riders, there will only be One Mechanic / One rider permitted in the Staging / Starting Line area. It is Mandatory for all Mechanics wear a face mask. Staging will close on the listed time, at that time the stager will close out any rider that was there past the cut off time. That rider will forfeit his/her gate pick, and will placed last on the picks.





## 9) Podium Procedure

There will not be a podium, or podium celebration. Top 3 riders will be guided to designated area, for TV interview, per moto. For the Overall Top 3, there will be a photo opportunity for Media and Teams, keeping riders separated by 6 feet (2 meters).

The podium area will be limited to Rider, Mechanic, Team Manager, TV crew and select Media sources.

## 10) 250 / 450 Pro Payout
